Do you like confrontation? You are in the minority if you do. Most people don't like confrontation at all. Many are petrified of it and tell themselves that it's just too hard. But the problem with running away from something is that you stay stuck in the issue or problem you're trying to escape. And you don't make any progress in the area of your life that it affects.

People run from all kinds of things—like something new, or change in general. They run from their past. And many people in our society run away from responsibility.

As believers, we are partners with God. This means that while God will do what we cannot do, we must do our part to make progress and accomplish what He has for us. And sometimes, this includes facing difficult people or situations and dealing with them instead of avoiding them.

Now personally, I never had too many problems confronting people. In fact, I used to be too confrontational, so the issue was more about how I handled confrontation. I had to learn how to approach difficult people and situations the way Jesus would do it. I also had to learn how to confront the devil, and every once in a while God will give me a refresher course on confronting the devil so I won't listen to his lies.

IT'S TIME TO STOP RUNNING


We need to be people who will no longer run away from hard situations—because God doesn't want us to be afraid. He wants us to be bold, courageous, and to know we can handle anything – through Christ – that comes our way.

First John 4:4 (AMPC) says, "Little children, you are of God [you belong to Him] and have [already] defeated and overcome them [the agents of the antichrist], because He Who lives in you is greater (mightier) than he who is in the world."

The next time you feel fearful about a situation or person that you know you need to confront, remember this scripture and remind yourself, "I'm not putting up with fear any longer because Jesus Christ lives in me. I can do whatever I need to do in life through Christ!"

FIND YOUR SOURCE OF STRENGTH

Maybe you just need to live with a little more oomph! I'm talking about Holy Spirit oomph that says, "I am God's child, and I'm not going to live in fear and let it keep me from everything God has for me. I will not run away from things. Because I can do whatever I need to do in life through Christ who strengthens me." (See Philippians 4:13.)



FACING YOUR FEARS

You can confront your problem. Or you can choose to run away from it. But if you run, the Bible is pretty clear as to what happens to people who run away from what God has called them to do...

They end up in the wilderness.

AVOIDERS WHO ENDED UP IN THE WILDERNESS

I want to talk about two people in the Bible who ran away when they were afraid and how God helped them confront their fear.

Moses – God had a destiny for Moses. But at forty years old, Moses did something wrong and instead of facing Pharaoh, he fled and “dwelt in the land of Midian” (Exodus 2:15 NKJV), which was a desert wilderness area outside of Egypt. He spent the next forty years in a holding pattern. God had to work some things out of Moses before he was ready, at age eighty, to go back and lead the Israelites out of their bondage.

Hagar – In Genesis we read how this servant girl got caught up in a really bad situation with Abraham and his wife, Sarah. When Hagar became pregnant by Abraham, which was Sarah’s idea, this created a big fight between her and Sarah. So Hagar ended up running away. The Bible says she ended up in the wilderness by a spring. Then an angel of God told her, “Go back to your mistress and [humbly] submit to her control” (Genesis 16:9 AMPC). Although it was definitely unpleasant and, I’m sure, extremely hard to do, Hagar did face her difficult situation because she knew God wanted her to do it.

There are other examples in the Bible of those who failed to confront their issues and ended up in the wilderness. What about you? Are you in a wilderness today because you are fearfully avoiding confrontation? You don’t have to stay there all your life and keep running away from things. Put your trust in Christ and do what He puts in your heart to do –by His grace and strength. You can get out of that wilderness and live in the promised land God has for you! 📌

LIVING FROM THE TREASURE WITHIN Part 1

John 10:10 says, *"The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows)." (Amplified).* The abundant life that Jesus has secured for every child of God, is one that is filled with purpose, freedom from the bondage of sin and its effects, and victory at every turn! The apostle Paul often refers to the victorious life a believer should be living, in the midst of turmoil and dangerous times. In fact, in **Philippians 4:13**, he goes as far to describe how someone living this abundant life will react when facing very difficult and challenging circumstances. He wrote, *"I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency]." (Amplified).*

Paul gave us a very simple, yet profound key that would unlock a life of supernatural power and strength, to combat every obstacle in life that would threaten to hold us back from living the full, abundant life Jesus intended us to live. This key is learning to live - not dependant on our own knowledge or strength - but dependant on the treasure that lives within us!

A magnificent, masterpiece...

In order for us to activate the power inside of us, we must have a very clear picture of exactly what resides within us as born again believers. **2 Corinthians 3:18** says that as we look into the word of God, like a mirror, we will be able to see a clear reflection of the miracle Jesus created inside of us - the day we surrendered our lives to Him. The

word teaches that at the point of our salvation, The Holy Spirit recreated our spirits into a brand new creation, one that resembled and displayed His brilliant, handiwork! In fact, in the book of **Ephesians 2:10**, it says, His work inside us was so glorious that when it was all finished, He declared us to be His own workmanship!


1 Corinthians 6:19,20, describe this magnificent, masterpiece of a creation as being a temple! *"Do you not know that your body is the temple (the very sanctuary) of the Holy Spirit Who lives within you, Whom you have received [as a Gift] from God? You are not your own,..."* In the Greek language, the word temple, is translated naos. Naos is described as being a highly decorated shrine! Now, I have seen some highly decorated shrines, and believe me, they do not look very appealing or beautiful to me, however, I believe that Paul was putting emphasis on the fact that firstly, the miracle God created inside of us was fashioned by His own creative nature and it resembles a spectacular display of beauty and perfection! Even the most beautiful scenes in nature cannot compare to the creative brilliance He fashioned inside of us, because nature is only a shadow of what it was before sin corrupted it. But our recreated spirits have not been tainted by sin, they are perfect, and untouched by sin and its destructive curse!

2 Corinthians 4:7, describes this magnificent, masterpiece God created inside of us by calling it a treasure! *"However, we possess this precious treasure [the divine Light of the Gospel] in [frail, human] vessels of earth, that the grandeur and exceeding greatness of the power may be shown to be from God and not from ourselves."*

The word treasure is the Greek word *thesauros*, a word that describes a treasure, or a treasure chamber, a place of safekeeping where riches and fortunes are kept. Greek scholar, Rick Renner, in his book, "Sparkling Gems from the Greek", describes this treasure chamber, as presenting the idea of a specially built room designed to be used for the safe keeping of massive riches and wealth. By using this word, Paul declares that we, as believers, are the possessors of riches beyond belief. We are the chambers, or treasuries where God has placed this fortune. Rick Renner goes on to say that within us, is a cache of wealth so immense that its reserves can never be completely dug out, unexplored, discovered, or discerned. These are spiritual assets beyond our wildest imagination!

This magnificent treasure within us, is the inexhaustible, limitless supply of the Spirit's power! Residing in every child of God is the immeasurable supply of Holy Ghost power that when activated, becomes unstoppable against any adverse circumstance or difficult challenge we will ever face. When we begin to live from the treasure within us, nothing will be impossible. The abundant life of purpose, freedom and victory will be our daily reality! ✠





A GENTLE ANSWER


We are living in turbulent times and we don't have to be a prophet to see that. Everywhere we look there is anger, there is confusion, there are malicious words being spoken without thought, and there's a lot of hurt taking place.

Early this morning while praying about using this subject as a column, I felt the Holy Spirit direct me to go to The Book of John 8, and to read the story of the adulterous woman and the Pharisees. The story is very simple. The Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery to Jesus, not primarily for justice, but to try and catch out the Lord so that they could eventually accuse Him and kill Him. Is it not amazing that so often harsh words are just the cover up for alternative reasons and motives which are unseen at the time? The Pharisees came to Jesus and they said, "According to the law of Moses this woman should be stoned, because she was caught in the act of adultery, but what do you say?" Jesus stooped down and He wrote on the ground with his finger (we don't know what He wrote, but He was totally calm and at peace). They continued to provoke Him and question Him. Eventually He stood up and said in John 8:7 (NKJV), "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first." Then He stooped down again and commenced to write on the ground.

Proverbs 15:1 says "A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger." Jesus then asked the woman, "Where are your accusers?" She said, "There are none!" He replied, "I don't accuse you either, go and sin no more! Your sins are forgiven." Like never before we need to watch what we say. I read that a harsh word is a word of pain. It is normally a word that causes a lot of hurt and a wise word will promote calm interactions. We need to encourage

one another rather than discourage one another. Sarcasm is the lowest form of wit, because you are always sarcastic at someone else's cost and not your own. We need to be very careful how we speak. The Bible tells us in The Book of James that the tongue is almost like a spark that can start a forest fire. We have seen that happen in our own beloved South Africa. A foolish, careless word spoken can cause so much pain, damage and could even cause a revolution.

But those of us who are ambassadors for Jesus Christ need to start to practice using gentle answers, especially when we are provoked unfairly. People will do that especially if they know that we are followers of Christ. They will try to manipulate and make us angry, but we must respond the same way as our Master, because He says we need to turn the other cheek and go the extra mile. It is not an easy thing to do, especially when those people that are doing it to us are purposefully trying to cause us to deny our stand for God. May the Lord bless you as you follow in His footsteps. ✚



10 Things I Wish Someone Had Told Me in Film School

Professors teach you knowledge about your field – and that’s a huge challenge, which is why they don’t often have time to teach about the relational issues of your field. Here are a handful of practical issues that I’ve learned over the years on TV and film sets around the world. Had I known them in college, it might have changed the direction of my career. Let me know what you think of this list:

1. Hollywood doesn’t care about you.

Silicon Valley doesn’t care about you. Nobody cares about you. You have to earn it. Don’t be the first in line at lunch. Give up your seat for a client. Don’t take the closest parking space. We all know you’re a genius and should actually be directing the movie, but right now, you need to pay your dues. Take charge of your career because nobody else will.

2. Resumes matter less than demo reels and portfolios.

It’s too easy to stretch the truth on a resume, plus, producers want to see your work. Make it compelling, and make it current.

Here are a few tips of making your demo reel memorable.

3. Write more.

It’s all about writing. Even if you won’t want to become a professional writer, study writing. After all, before you decide to spend the next year working on a film, you need to know if the script is worth it.

4. Know how television REALLY works.

When I started in my career, I had no idea what a “show runner” was. In fact, although the role existed, I don’t think that title was actually invented. But with my skill set, it would have been the perfect career path. But because I didn’t know the business, I spent too many years moving in the wrong direction.

5. Pursue YOUR vision, not someone else’s.

Certainly you can start your career doing projects for other people. But if you’re serious about changing the world, don’t live at someone else’s whim.

6. Learn the importance of the niche.

Be the best in the world at a really narrow brand. Read my book “One Big Thing.” It will transform your perception, focus, and identity in the industry.

7. Consider starting as an assistant.

When I left college, I wanted to direct, so it never occurred to me to get an office job, or work as an assistant. But recently, a former assistant of mine eventually moved to Disney, and now has taken a job as a financial manager for Marvel and is leaving this week to work on the next Spider-man movie. Another assistant of mine ended up taking the Director’s Guild assistant director’s test, and graduated to work on “The Office” and is now an A.D. on network TV dramas. Being an assistant allows you to develop relationships, and learn how the business is done from the inside. Being an assistant isn’t for everyone, but I’d encourage you to consider it.

8. Being a Christian isn’t the problem in Hollywood.

Being lousy is. In this post I talk about why Hollywood isn’t anti-Christian. What Hollywood happens to be is anti-lousy. Excellence matters.

9. C.S. Lewis’ stepson, Douglas Gresham had it right:

We don’t need more Christian movies, we need more Christians making good movies.

10. Learn the power of networking, because it’s far more than simply shameless self-promotion.

The truth is, people just like to work with people they know. Work is always better when you’re doing it with friends. In my experience, most people would turn down a better candidate to work with someone they know and respect. 📌



Is Hollywood
Anti-Christian?

I get asked (usually from Christian media) if I believe Hollywood is anti-Christian. I understand the question, because it's pretty easy to see that Judeo-Christian values aren't exactly the hot button these days in the movie and television industries. And yet, to make a blanket statement that Hollywood is the enemy is a big mistake. Recently, I discussed the issue with a major Christian media site, and here's what I told them. I'd love to hear your comments about my answers:

1. What's your response when you hear Christians complain that Hollywood is anti-Christian?

It certainly hasn't been true in my experience. Obviously there are people in Hollywood who don't like religion, just like there are attorneys, school teachers, plumbers, and store clerks across the country who don't like religion. But in my experience the vast majority of producers, actors, filmmakers, and studio executives in Hollywood are very open. In most cases (again, like the general culture) these men and women weren't raised in a Christian home, so they're largely ignorant of any knowledge about the Christian faith. But that doesn't make them "anti-faith." In fact, I've had some remarkable conversations with industry leaders about Christianity, and you'd be amazed at the number of highly placed entertainment and media professionals who are believers.

2. But what about specific examples of Hollywood being anti-faith?

I think in most cases, the idea that Hollywood is "anti-faith" is a gimmick used by some Christian organizations to raise money. It's a well-used technique in fundraising to create an enemy so your followers will respond. I also believe that some Christians can be too quick to use terms like "mockery" when movies don't portray Bible stories accurately. Most filmmakers don't believe the Bible, but that doesn't mean they don't see the value in its great stories. However, since they're not believers, they don't feel the loyalty to the story that we do, so as creative artists, they don't see a problem deviating from the storyline. But it's not about "mockery" or being "anti-faith."

3. Until 2013, Hollywood rarely touched faith. TV still keeps an arm's distance from religious topics. Why is this, especially in light of the success of shows like "7th Heaven?"

To be honest, that program was popular an entire generation ago, so it's not really relevant to the conversation. Tastes change, culture changes, trends change, people change – so you can't really compare what was popular 20+ years ago with what's popular today. Keep in mind that Hollywood is a business – not a religious organization, so their goal (like any other business) is to make a profit for their investors and shareholders. Creative people create based on what they know, and frankly, as I mentioned before, most Hollywood professionals simply didn't grow up in Christian families, so to produce faith-based programming simply isn't on their radar. One important inroad I've made is to point out to studios that Hollywood bends over backwards to reach special interest groups of all kinds – like feminists, environmentalists, the gay community, the military, gamers, etc. – but by the numbers, Christians are the largest "special interest" group there is. And yet many in Hollywood don't understand what makes us tick. There are a handful of us in town trying to turn that around, and after years working in the industry, I can say that for the vast majority of cases, it's simply a world they've never grown up in or encountered.

4. Is there anything Christians do to improve the lack of faith-related programming in Hollywood (rather than simply complain)?

• It's my position that boycotts, petition drives, etc. are very damaging to our cause. If that worked, then why don't missionaries do it? Why don't

missionaries surround a Third World village, hold up signs, call them names, and threaten to never do business with them? Boy, THAT would win them to Christ. Not!

What do missionaries do? They work from the inside, building relationships, earning trust, and becoming one of them. Once they've earned the right to speak, that's when change happens.

• Let's preview movies and tell Christians (especially families with kids) what's in them. I'm all for reviews and recommendations that let people know what's there so they can decide for themselves. Everyone has the right not to see a movie, but when it comes to major, orchestrated criticism, let's actually see the movie before we launch a national campaign. I'm a firm believer that to criticize a movie, book, TV program or other endeavour in the media without actually seeing it is intellectually dishonest. When Christian leaders mount massive campaigns against movies they haven't even seen it really hurts our credibility outside the Christian bubble.

• I'd like to see the Christian community criticize less and begin raising up our own filmmakers, writers, and producers to go into the industry. Let's focus less on making explicitly "Christian" films and more on getting Christian thinking into mainstream movies. Even with the success of a few movies like "God's Not Dead," they're largely seen by the choir. That's not influencing the culture. I'm talking about the same strategy the gay community used and it was brilliant. They helped find talented gay filmmakers, developed relationships with studios and TV networks, mentored them, and helped fund their projects. And just look at the results. We're actually in the early stages of that strategy with an organization we've launched called "The Influence Lab."

• Finally (and here's a novel idea) let's pray for Hollywood. If we really believe that God answers prayer, what if we started encouraging Christians to pray for the most influential industry on the planet? What if we started praying for the thousands of dedicated believers working inside the industry every day? I think that would have far greater results than boycotts, petition drives, and criticism. For help starting, check out The Hollywood Prayer Network.

5. What trends, if any, when it comes to film and TV content are troubling to you (sex, violence, etc.)?

A very big issue for me is how technology has made pornography so readily available to children. It's not just movies or TV, its video games, the Internet, and now mobile devices. I'm stunned at how few parents monitor their children's computer use or use anti-porn filters on computers. I also encourage parents to never allow young people to have computers in their bedroom. When our daughters were young, we kept all the computers out in the open where everyone could see what they were doing. The question is – what will a culture look like when boys have been raised with pornography so readily available? It will dramatically change their views and expectations of women, and we're already seeing that evidence.

6. What has been the biggest lesson you've learned about faith in Hollywood?

Never be afraid to be a Christian in Hollywood. Trust me – there are folks out here who hug trees and worship rocks, so being a Christian isn't as weird as some think. And if you want to make an impact, don't lead with your faith. Lead with your talent – your acting, writing, directing, or producing abilities. Once they notice and respect your talent, they're much more willing to listen to anything else you have to say. ✦

GROWING INTERNAL QUALITIES

“Businessman extraordinaire and investing genius Warren Buffett wants kids to learn about business at a young age – not so they can start buying stocks with their lunch money, but so they can develop smart habits that will help them in business and throughout their future. Warren Buffet reckons that when a child between ages 8-10 learns the basics of how finance works and how to behave in a business relationship, he or she can apply those lessons throughout their lives, not just for business, but for a person’s happiness and even how their families develop” (www.inc.com).

The reason Buffet gives this advice is purely because it is relevant for our times. Furthermore, this kind of advice from wise and mature business people is also needed since not enough time is dedicated during a full school day to prepare young people for this economy. Specialists are not so much in need for this economy as is the person that is willing to do anything to put food on the table.

An unfulfilled person is more likely to take part in violent mass actions than the one who is keeping himself busy with a daily task, bringing in funds needed to help raise a family. It affects the morale of a nation if there is no hope to become effective in applying oneself in your giftedness. It is a gift of God to be healthy and we must aim to work with our hands and mind, applying ourselves to our affairs (1 Thessalonians 4:11).

During my frequent consultations I remind parents (and other adults responsible for education) that they are able to influence their children from young to have their own business, and also to have them practice different skills and components required in a business.

Critical to the success of any business are the 4 P’s which make up the standard marketing mix: **Price, Product, Place and Promotion.** This simply means that no matter what product or business you have, it needs to be promoted so that people can buy into it. All 4 P’s need to get equal attention for a business to work. Others must become aware of your product or have an interest in it or know what kind of services you are offering. “The marketing mix refers to the set of actions, or tactics, that a company uses to promote its brand or product in the market” (purelybranded.com/insights/the-four-ps-of-marketing).

Some people do not have the natural ability to promote either a business or themselves. They are either too introverted or nervous, and at times feel “too intelligent” to sell a product to others or to talk in front of others. A parent with this kind of hesitancy will find it harder to guide their child in this economy as they will only rely on the systems they knew in such as 12 years of school, a matric certificate, and then a degree. Also, this type of shy child would do well in academic subjects but when it comes to expressing themselves, he or she will find it hard to creatively express himself in person and on paper. This person would find it hard to sell or promote anything, even though they might have all the knowledge.

The current world economy requires people to be more risk taking, flexible and entrepreneurial. In some instances companies require prospective employees to prove to the company

directors why they must employ him or her. Failing to do so adequately may, in some instances, result in the candidate not getting the job, even if he or she is technically and academically qualified for the job.

As believers, we are children of God and with His Spirit in us are able to learn new skills, take steps into the unknown and go places that we never would otherwise dare to go, all for the sake of being relevant in the Kingdom.

I urge parents and other educators to guide and groom children from a young age to excel in the skill of public speaking. Also to grow the willingness to promote a cause, product or value when needed. This promotion can be digital where, for instance, writing on a blog, advertising through web pages, answering product questions through email requires no public speaking. The more introverted child does not have to be an extrovert to have a successful business, but he must be willing to take his product to the market. Being aware of their introverted nature they can compensate by using digital tools to assist in tasks, or work interdependently with others to do the marketing.

It is clear that other kind of skills are needed for this economy and the typical "naughty, strong-willed child" might have exactly the skills needed to 'make it' in this world (www.inc.com).

Practical guidance to parents:

1. Communication is a very important skill, so parents must make sure their children can speak to others and get, or relay information adequately, whether verbally or digitally.
2. If a child has unwillingness in doing this, it needs to be exercised in a safe environment, namely the home or a small group. Talk to your children in the car, let them tell you what they have learnt during the day. Let them record themselves when they speak on your cell phone, which will be harder for the introvert.
3. Let your children start with their own businesses even if it is the wrong business and they might fail. It is what they learn in the process that is important – it is as important to learn what you don't want to do as it is to learn what you want to do as a venture.
4. The character development in the process of mentoring your children is much more important. It is not just about making money but about finding your unique place in this world and how we can make this world a better place by purposefully interacting with God's people and His gifts. It is about growing the internal qualities for this economy, which is, for example, perseverance, dedication, honesty, and integrity.

At the age of fifteen, Jesus became a full-time apprentice in Joseph's workshop. Apart from teaching his son the Law, it was a Jewish father's duty to teach his son a trade. He was a carpenter. A trade in Palestine was a family enterprise. "As there was no institution for vocational training, the son would learn the trade through being taught by either his father or another male relative on the basis of apprenticeship. The instruction method was essentially oral" (Gunter Krall, *Man: Mentoring for Mission*). For years I have advocated that education is simple and it is as a part of life as eating, drinking and sleeping. However, most families do not realise the full benefits of it as do not apply it enough in their daily lives. One reason is that fathers are not talking enough to their children. If parents teach their children everything they know, their children will know more than what they ever could learn in a school, but often parents fail to do that. My final advice is to invest in a large family table and use every opportunity to communicate, to interact and then duplicate through close association. 📌

Transformation

The definition of transformation (noun) is the act or process of transforming, the state of being transformed, and also a change in form, appearance, nature, or character. In essence transformation speaks about a continuing and continual process. The reason I am bringing this up is that a principal character trait of all humans is precisely this! It seems to be an essential ingredient of our DNA right from the day of our creation. And since we are called the crown of God's creation, it stands to reason that the environment we are living in is also subject to this process. In order for us to fully experience the presence of God, and to fully appreciate our relationship with Him, we also need to be fully aware of the "process of life."

We find the principle of transformation in the very first instruction we receive from God; he places us in the environment He created and in the atmosphere of His Spirit, and then says, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule..." (Genesis 1:28a). Without bringing about change, and without transforming something basic into something else it is impossible to be fruitful, to fill, to subdue or to rule. God later confirms this with the instruction, "I am the Lord your God; consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am holy" (Leviticus 11:44). Consecration and the process of becoming holy is also referred to in Scripture as sanctification, a key ingredient of our walk with the Lord.

God gave the same instruction to Cain when He said, "Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it" (Genesis 4:6-7). Some

translations put it as "you must master sin." In the mastering of anything, a process is implicit - one cannot become a master at anything without the process of failing and trying again, and the process of becoming better at something. Implicit in God's instruction is also His grace - the grace of forgiving our mistakes and the grace to strengthen us to do better than before in order for Him to get the glory. So, in a sense, transformation and grace are inextricably linked!

No matter where we find ourselves, on the right or wrong side of the track, the process will always follow us. Look at the process of moving away from God and forsaking a right relationship with Him: "Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers..." (Psalms 1:1). The process of "falling away" is simple - walking, then standing, and lastly sitting. Walking may be likened to "flirting with danger," standing to seriously starting to consider the flirtations, and lastly sitting, and indication of comfort and acceptance. Jesus speaks about the same process when He warns His disciples, "Walk while you have the Light [keep on living by it], so that darkness will not overtake you" (John 12:35). While one is walking in step with the Light all is fine' however, when one stands still, or even sit down, darkness will overtake and overcome one!

Paul writes to the New Testament churches and encourages a walk of transformation, and a lifestyle focused on having one's human nature changed into that of Christ. Yes, he was encouraging sanctification! To the church at Corinth he writes, "And we all, with unveiled face, continually seeing as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are

progressively being transformed into His image from [one degree of] glory to [even more] glory, which comes from the Lord, [who is] the Spirit" (2 Corinthians 3:18), while he encourages the Christians in Rome, "And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His plan and purpose for you]" (Romans 12:1).

With the exception, I suppose, of a total miracle, it is impossible for us to experience instantaneous results in any situation. Thus we cannot simply "fall into" sin, or for that matter, "fall out of sin," but rather we are subject to the process that goes with that. Falling into sin is a gradual process from flirting in thought, to considering in thought, and then sitting in an action. The opposite is true as well - while forgiveness is instantaneous and immediate, we often still have to deal with the consequences of whatever it is we were forgiven from. And so our entire existence is a process of getting to know God. The amazing thing is this - even after we depart earth and enter eternity for the final time, this process continues. Jesus defines "eternal life" simply as the process of getting to know God (John 17:3). And since God has no beginning or end, the process of our existence, and the accompanying transformation of ourselves is equally without end. Once we accept this as the foundation of our relationship with God, that union becomes richer and more fulfilling, and the distractions of this world become infinitely less tempting! Viva la transformation! ✚
