FROM THE EDITOR

One thing that people all over the world are in one accord with is that the youth of today are the leaders of tomorrow. It makes sense then that we should spend extraordinary time, effort and finances in training up the young people in our communities to fill the places and positions they are destined to control in the near future. Biblical examples abound where the Great Designer has put in place strategies and plans to help adults (those who are more mature) in training up the young. Moses tells us in Deuteronomy: "This is the commandment, the rules and regulations, that God, your God, commanded me to teach you to live out in the land you're about to cross into to possess. This is so that you'll live in deep reverence before God lifelong, observing all his rules and regulations that I'm commanding you, you and your children and your grandchildren, living good long lives... Love God, your God, with your whole heart: love him with all that's in you, love him with all you've got! Write these commandments that I've given you today on your hearts. Get them inside of you and then get them inside your children. Talk about them wherever you are, sitting at home or walking in the street; talk about them from the time you get up in the morning to when you fall into bed at night." Jesus encourages us further to accept His words as children do, simply because they are so susceptible to learning things when they are young. Solomon writes in the Proverbs that we should train our children in the way they should be going in their future when they are young, and that when they reach a mature age they won't depart from it since it is already written on their hearts.

The moment that those who are responsible for the training of the youth falter in their mandate and mess with the education system of a community we are in for a rough future. Unfortunately, the world over, a humanistic approach to life has eroded the responsibility of adults training the young by wrongfully empowering the immature in favour of the mature. Examples are heard in the news literally every day where the rights of parents have been encroached upon, and where children have the 'legal right' to sue their parents for assumed wrongs. The basic problem of our New Age society (seemingly the pervading world-view) is absolutes have been removed and replaced with human rights; I see "human rights" the same way that I see discipline - there can be no real understanding of the rights we have outside of the borders of an absolute. The absolutes I am speaking about are the parameters set in place by the Great Designer of everything. God has kindly left us an instruction manual explaining all the laws that govern the world and those who dwell on earth. It is within this context only that we can take up our rightful place in ensuring we equip a future generation to take up the torch and make earth a better place for all. Our responsibility has been broadened in South Africa due to the very large proportion of young people in our population demographic; this is largely due to the effects of AIDS and TB (1 out of every 10 South Africans suffer from the latter), the resultant deaths of adults and the growing population of orphans. We need to embrace our educational responsibility and ensure that we create an environment that is safe, friendly and open to growth for all our children.

I JUST WANT TO BE HAPPY!

How many times have we heard that cry, either from those around us or even our own, frustrated hearts? Sometimes we think we will only be happy when things go the way we want them to go. When we don't have to work so hard to achieve what we desire. Or when we reach the goals we have set, whether financial or professional. Sometimes, as children of God, we believe true happiness is obtained when we see the fulfilment of our prayers.

The truth is, the list of what we think happiness is, could go on forever and constantly change, depending on where we are in our lives. Today I read a simple, yet profound statement that said, "Thankfulness is the prerequisite to happiness, because only a thankful heart can be a happy heart" (Rick Renner, Sparkling Gems from the Greek Volume 2). So, if happiness is our pursuit, and the Word tells us that a thankful heart is what is going to get us there - then let's look at what it really means to be thankful!

Being Thankful Is God's Will for Us

According to 1 Thessalonians 5:18, being thankful is God's will for us. It says, "...in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Oh, the amount of times I have sincerely confessed, "I just want to do God's will..."! I know you have too, in fact it's perfectly appropriate for every child of God to have the desire to follow the will of our Heavenly Father. And do you know what I have found to be true? It's these small, yet extremely important instructions that produce the greatest blessing when we apply them to our lives.

Thankfulness is a Choice

Everybody wants to be happy, right? Since a thankful heart is a prerequisite to a happy heart, it would certainly be in our best interest to investigate all we can concerning being thankful. I must say the most compelling advocate for thankfulness is that it's God's will for every believer. And the benefits of walking in obedience to God's will... which brings us to the truth that thankfulness is a choice of obedience. Paul says we are to be thankful in everything. That phrase, in the Greek language, means in every detail, or even in the smallest way. Renner (ibid) refers to one Bible translation that says, "In every circumstance, be thankful..."

You may feel that the circumstances you are facing could be far more pleasant than they currently appear.

I'm convinced we all have difficulties in our lives we would rather go without having to encounter. Didn't Jesus teach us that dangerous, perilous times would become increasingly common place in the world around us too?

Frankly, being grateful in challenging circumstances, is probably the last thing on anybody's mind. That's why it's important to note, the Word doesn't say to be thankful FOR the circumstances, it says be thankful IN them. That means, don't accept any trial as being something you were meant to endure, as though it is your 'lot' in life. That kind of thinking contradicts the Word. Scripture teaches us to have faith to receive the promises of God and move the mountains in our lives. Many people misinterpret Paul's words, when he says he has learnt to be content in all circumstances. He wasn't settling for the lack or hard times, he was making a choice, that while he faced those challenges, he would keep up his faith and not complain or fear, but rather believe the promises of God until they become his reality.

Paul's advice was, that while we are experiencing unpleasant circumstances, we must choose to turn our eyes towards the good in our lives, and away from the things that try to bring discouragement. Keeping our focus on the negativity only steals our peace and quenches our joy. That doesn't

mean choosing to live in a state of denial, hoping the problems will just go away if we ignore them long enough. No, that would also contradict the Word. The Bible is full of powerful teachings on how to pray effective, faith filled prayers, with the expectation of seeing our circumstances change. Rather, choosing to be thankful, is a simple act of obedience. After we decide to lay our burdens at the feet of Jesus, and prayerfully consult His wisdom concerning them, we choose to focus on what is good in our lives, and not fret or worry.

Thankfulness is that attitude that keeps us walking in peaceful expectancy, while God's Word goes to work in our lives. When it comes to experiencing victory in this life, an attitude of gratefulness is exactly what empowers our faith to believe and receive what the Lord has promised us in His Word, concerning every circumstance.



Most importantly, we run a programme that is founded on Biblical principles with Jesus Christ as the foundation stone.



ONE SIMPLE WAY TO INCREASE YOUR JOY

I love God's Word because it is our instructional manual for life! In fact, there is an answer for every problem we face in the Bible, including how to make a bad day better...and increase our joy every single day.

For example, if you're having a bad day, one of the worst things you can do is to keep thinking about yourself and all of your own problems. It only makes things worse! The best thing you can do is get your mind off yourself and help someone else.

The apostle Paul says in Acts 20:35: "In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive'" (NIV).

So, if I'm having a bad day, this Scripture tells me I can be happier by simply getting myself off my mind and helping someone else.

Helping others isn't something you may feel like doing—it requires a decision, especially when you're concerned about a problem or just feeling down. But making a choice to be good to others has the power to help you and them. It's a spiritual principle that "it is more blessed to give than to receive."

It's actually amazing how just a few words of encouragement can change someone's entire day. Sometimes it can even change their life!

It can be as simple as picking up the phone and calling a friend who's been going through a rough time, letting them know you're thinking about them and praying for their situation. Or maybe you can send someone a text message to let them know how valuable they are and how much you care.

If you're wondering, "How does helping someone else make me happier?" then just think about Christmas morning.

You've spent time shopping for gifts, spending your money and sacrificing financially. You've also wrapped them and placed them under the tree for your kids or relatives. And now it's finally time to open them!

Sure, it's fun to receive a gift and open it; however, the best part is watching others open their gifts. Why? Because you have sacrificed, spent your time and money and really invested something into this. So, as you watch them open and enjoy what you did for them, great joy is released in your life.

I recently read a tremendous story on this topic about William Booth, the founder of The Salvation Army. It was Christmas Eve, 1910, and due to sickness, he wasn't going to be able to attend the organization's annual convention. He had become an invalid, and his eyesight was failing.

Normally, Booth would speak to the workers and share an encouraging message with these men and women who had spent long hours in service during the Christmas season. But this year, knowing he couldn't attend, he decided to send a message by telegram that could be read to all those in attendance.

Booth searched his heart and mind and reviewed his years of ministry, looking for a message that would summarize his life and the mission of The Salvation Army. He wanted to compose a speech that would encourage these men and women.

That night, when the thousands of delegates met, the moderator shared the news that William Booth would not be present due to his failing health. They were naturally disappointed; however, he conveyed that Booth had sent something he wanted to share with them in his absence.

The moderator opened the telegram, then read William Booth's one-word message: "Others."

This story really speaks to me! It's so easy to always focus on ourselves—what we want and what we think. But we often have it backward. Remember Acts 20:35: God is saying when we make others our priority, then everything else will fall into place...and we will end up incredibly happy.

Here's another scripture that says it well: "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well" (Matthew 6:33 NIV).

God's Word clearly shows us that when we have a need in our own life, helping others is one of the most powerful things we can do!

Are you going through a difficult time? Are you waiting for a breakthrough in a certain area? If so, Psalm 37:3 has the answer for every problem you will face:

"Trust (lean on, rely on, and be confident) in the Lord and do good; so shall you dwell in the land and feed surely on His faithfulness, and truly you shall be fed" (AMPC).

The bottom line here is: Trust God and do good! Because when you place your trust and hope in the Lord and commit yourself to helping others and taking care of their problems, you open the door for God to do incredible things in your own life.

Would you like to make every day better? Would you like to find joy even in the midst of difficult times? Then begin taking just a few minutes every day to think about what you can do to help someone else.


You'll find that when you make others your focus, God's blessings will always come back to you!





TRUST RISES FROM UNDERSTANDING THE ONE WE WORSHIP

JACI VELASQUEZ

For more than half her life, multi-platinum-selling, Grammy nominated artist Jaci Velasquez has pursued an entertainer's dream, recording albums in English and Spanish and performing on stages around the world. From her debut at age 16, she has leaned full-throttle into her God-given gifts, racking up 16 No. 1 hits, penning three books, acting in seven films, gracing 50 magazine covers and launching a non-profit clothing line.

But the dream has seen its share of soul-searching questions, loves and losses, enough to bring any young woman to her knees. And just as the lyric of her 2006 hit "On My Knees" predicted, she has learned, in laughter or in pain, to survive. Her survival is built on trust. "I may not know what to do or what the future holds," she says, "but I trust that God does."

Internationally released March 31, *Trust* marks several firsts for Velasquez, a Dove Award winner and Billboard Latin Music Award winner with five Spanish albums to her credit. Not only is it her first album in over five years, her first worship album and her first project with Integrity Music, this 18th recording is the first simultaneously released in both English (*Trust*) and Spanish (*Confío*).

Produced by David Leonard (All Sons & Daughters) and Chris Bevins (Salvador, Phillips, Craig & Dean), *Trust* finds Velasquez taking a decidedly vertical turn, exploring new territory where her faith has been bolstered through seasons of uncertainty that led to a place of complete trust.

Certainly, it is a reflection of how her faith has been shaped and strengthened by motherhood with the added challenges of being mom to a special needs child. "We started

noticing when Zealand was two," she says, "but the official diagnosis came in 2nd grade. When they told us it was Autism, I went through a time of mourning the death of the dreams I had for him." It took some time, but she began to dream new dreams for her son, "harvesting the gifts I could see in him." Today, at 9, Zealand excels in music, in both singing and piano. "His ear is even better than mine," his proud mom says.

"Everybody has faith in something," says Jaci, who served as the 2013 spokesperson for Autism Speaks' Tennessee Walk Now. "But at the end of the day, if you're looking to yourself to keep everything under control, God isn't part of the equation. That's where trust comes in, understanding that God loves your children even more than you do."

Trust features 10 anthems that sing of God's faithfulness, a modern worship and pop hybrid sure to resonate with anyone caught up in the chaotic uncertainty of the everyday.

"I don't know a lot about worship as a music genre," Velasquez freely admits, "but I know how God can use music to move people. What we experience in church, in worship, we want to have that experience every day... at home, in the car. In the middle of the day, God uses it to meet us in the middle of our chaos, to move us closer to him, to remind us of who we are and who He is." In fact, she really wasn't convinced a worship album was meant to be until she found herself comforting her youngest son, Soren, 7, in the middle of the night, after a bad dream.

"When you're scared and don't know what to do, I want you to remember this," she told him. Then she played "God Who Moves Mountains," written by David Leonard, Dustin Smith and Richie Fike. Standing in his room, she closed her eyes and, as the words washed over mom and boy, she raised her hands. When the song was over, they both had tears in their eyes. "Our lives were changed in that moment because God met us there in a song," she says. "Music is powerful and healing."

"Rest," a melodic ballad co-written with her husband Nic Gonzales (Salvador) and Greg Sykes, will undoubtedly resonate with mothers and fathers who hit the ground running all day, every day. Sitting down at 10pm for her first meal of the day, looking at a 4:20am wake up time for the next day, Velasquez realized she hadn't even talked to God all day long. "If I don't rest, I'm just spinning my wheels," she says of the song's origins the next day. "It's not going to mean anything unless I give it all to him."

A percussion-driven joyride, "The Sound of Your Kingdom," written by indie-artist Ryan Corn, is as contagious as a song can get. "I fell in love with it, not only for what it says, but for how it makes you feel," Velasquez says. "When God sees us, he hears what we offer back to him—our worship, our joy, our laughter, our honor, blessing and praise—that's the sound of his kingdom." One of her boys' favorites and a great reminder that we're part of something really big and ongoing, she says.

From "Praise The King," a phenomenal Easter-every-day celebration, to "Great Are You Lord," an ethereal anthem/duet with her husband, to Martin Smith's "Great Is Your Faithfulness," to "Never As Dark As It Seems," a powerful reminder for tumultuous times written by Michael Farren, Mike Grayson and Seth Moseley—Trust echoes the courage that rises from understanding the One we worship.

When my body's shaking, my faith won't be broken / You lift me up, my heart is wide open I know you are my light, and I trust you

"Trust You," which Velasquez wrote with Aruna Abrams, James Slater and Bobby Hamrick, encapsulates the heart of the album.

"I remember, before Zealand was diagnosed, sobbing in the office of the school," Velasquez recalls. "All I could do was cry, my body was shaking in fear. It took a while to lay it all down, to trust God with my sons, to trust God with my marriage, walking that out as a child of God, as a wife and a mom, trusting him to make all things possible, to move the mountains in our lives..." It's the underlying theme of this record, she says, but more than that, "it's everything."

DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOU ARE GOING?

There is an old saying that goes, "The world stands aside for a man who knows where he is going." The question is, do you know where you are going?

In The Bible, we see one of the giants, Moses, was a man who knew where he was going. Why? Simply because he had a personal relationship with God. If you have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, namely spending time with Him each day, reading His Word, praying in a personal way, reading a devotional, spending time listening to Christian music before the day commences, you will know exactly where you are going. The Bible is our compass. It prevents us from going down a cul-de-sac because that just a waste of time, because we have to come straight back up the highway and start off again. We cannot afford to do that in these last days.

Moses knew where he was going. Moses had no doubt about where he was going because he was leading two and a half million Jews through a treacherous desert. I have been there myself, nothing lives there. It looks like the face of the moon. They say the temperatures exceed 50° in the

summer. For 40 years Moses was in charge of the well-being of God's people. They were fed every single day with fresh manna from heaven. The literal translation of manna is "What's that?" It was a beautiful honey flavoured wafer that settled on the ground every morning. The Israelites collected it up and that kept them living. Water literally came out of a rock. Their shoes never wore out and the animals never died for 40 years.

Moses had to know where he was going. I love the title that he is given in Deuteronomy 33:1: Moses, the man of God. If you want to be a man, or woman, of God in these last days you have to know where you are going. Psalm 119:105 (NKJV), "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." The more time you spend in The Bible, the less mistakes you will make and the less chances of you getting lost. We cannot afford to get lost in the madness of these last days. We cannot afford to get lost in double standards, in compromise, in dabbling in other faiths.

We need to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus alone. He will lead us not only through the desert, but all the way home.

When my children were young - all of them are parents now - we would sit in my little wattle house on the Shalom Farm. We had a lightning plant, no electricity, no telephone and no television. I would sit there every night before they went to sleep and I would read them a chapter out of the book Pilgrims Progress. It is a story of Christian and his journey to the Celestial City (Heaven). It is about how he is tested on the way. He is tempted, he gets attacked by all kinds of different circumstances and people with names like Laziness, Slothfulness, and Fear. And of course, he meets many good friends like Hope and Faith etc. I feel like we are on a similar journey and our destination is to be in heaven with God forever.

We have our Lord Holy Spirit (Paracletos – the helper) who will see us through. (John 16:7 NKJV). But we need to be as disciplined as Moses was. We need to be careful about the company we keep and the advice that we take. We need to be sure that our families are with us, all of them. That none will be lost and the Lord Jesus Christ Himself would take us by the hand and will lead us home.

I would be the last person in the world to say to you that once you come to Jesus all your trials and tribulations will be over. I know that from my Comrades Marathon experience. It is so tempting to sit down for a while but then you will never have the strength to get up again. We need to run the race, we need to complete it, and the best way is to go straight from A to B, not back and forwards, up and down, because that will wear us out.

May the Lord Jesus Christ bless you in this beautiful year of 2017. Do not look behind you, that is absolutely fatal. In fact, as an old farmer I can tell you that "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God." Luke 9:62 (NKJV). Simply because if we keep looking behind we cannot plough in a straight line. We need to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, the author and the perfecter of our faith (Hebrews 12:1-2).

When you know where you are going you will find that many others will follow you. Your family will not follow you, if they know that you yourself are not convinced that the route that you are taking is the correct one. The best way to ensure that you are on the right road is to spend time reading God's holy word and spending time in prayer, in His presence. 📖

I remember a story many years ago, of a family of missionaries that were dropped off by a sailing ship on an island where there were cannibals living. The ship left the missionaries on that island and most of them died, but one survived and they allowed him to live for only one reason; he must never speak about Jesus Christ, and he must live in silence. Well, a hundred years went past and then another sailing ship came to the same island. The missionaries presented the Gospel of Jesus Christ to these islanders, who by now were drastically changed and had become peaceful people, but when they were telling the story of Christ the islanders were not surprised in any way. One of the missionaries stopped in the middle of the story and asked whether they knew this Man that they were talking about? They all nodded and said, "We do know Him and He actually used to live on this island."

Then they took the missionaries up in the hills and there was a little gravesite nicely cleaned and a cross painted in white. There was the body of the missionary who had died eventually on the island. He never spoke and said anything, but he lived the life, he died to self, and lived for these people. He preached Jesus Christ by his actions and not just by his words.

We need to be the same, words are very cheap, but it's our actions that costs. The people of this world are desperate for the truth and Jesus is the truth. May God bless you, as you start to live Christ and not just talk about Him.
