From The Editor

God created us to exist and experience life by all our senses - see, hear, taste, smell and touch. However, as much as we experience these senses in the physical realm, it is also possible to experience them at a spiritual level! And the Bible (referred to as the Word of God) abounds with examples.

Before we can continue down this line of enquiry, we must understand that we were created in the image of God, that is, we were created to be just like Him. This tells me that as much as I am a sensual being (existing by and through my senses), God has the same senses. Now, I do understand that God is Spirit, meaning that He really does not embody a physical shape. At the same time, He does exist (within Himself) also by these.

We read, ***"In the beginning God created [by forming from nothing] the heavens and the earth. The earth was formless and void or a waste and emptiness, and darkness was upon the face of the deep [primeval ocean that covered the unformed earth]. The Spirit of God was moving (hovering, brooding) over the face of the waters. And God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light"*** (Genesis 1:1-3)

Here we see that God speaks. This means that the Spirit (hovering on the water) could hear God. However, since God is Spirit and has no physical

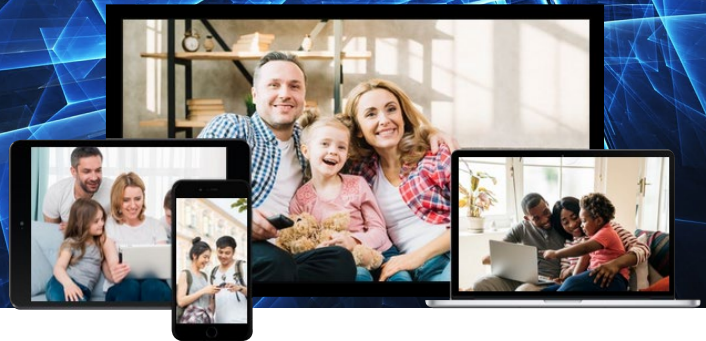
shape or form, it also means that He has no vocal cords, which leads us to ask the question, ***"How does God then speak?"*** A further study of the Bible answers this for us, but more than this, encourages us to be able to speak also without words. If then we are able to speak without words, it is safe to assume we are also able to hear without our ears!

Since I understand the purpose of my creation to be a relationship with God, it does give some indication of how this is possible. We read further in Genesis, ***"God saw that the light was good (pleasing, useful) and He affirmed and sustained it"*** (Genesis 1:4a). Again we are faced with a seeming conundrum - if God is Spirit and existing outside of a physical body, how does He see? It is obvious that our physical senses have an ulterior purpose! So, we can speak without words, hear without ears and see without eyes... but we still can hear and see, just like God in Whose image we are created.

I sense some exciting discoveries ahead! Enjoy each of the articles in this issue as you discover for yourself the majesty and awesomeness of our Creator - we trust that it will inspire you to be renewed in your relationship with God, and that it will encourage you to explore new dimensions in your worship.

Do Not Doubt

We have been looking at our walk of faith, what it is, how it works, and how we can discover God's love and grace through faith daily. One way in which our faith can be hampered is when we doubt the Word.

Often, when we don't see the results we want, when we want - doubt sets in. The first tell-tale sign of doubt is in our words. Just as faith is carried on our words that align with scripture, doubt is carried out on our negative words, and has the power to make our faith completely inoperative. The book of James says that we mustn't even expect to receive anything if we have doubt. James 1:6-8 says, ***"Only it must be in faith that he asks with no wavering (no hesitating, no doubting). For the one who wavers (hesitates, doubts) is like the billowing surge out at sea that is blown hither and thither and tossed by the wind. For truly, let not such a person imagine that he will receive anything [he asks for] from the Lord, [For being as he is] a man of two minds (hesitating, dubious, irresolute), [he is] unstable and unreliable and uncertain about everything [he thinks, feels, decides]."***

The Bible says we must keep a vigilant watch over the words we speak, so determine to never allow your words to carry doubt because they disagree with God's own words.

Another deterrent of active faith is the way we perceive God's Word.

See God's Word as Himself

Something that will help you counter the temptation to doubt is to change your perspective of God's Word. It's easy for Christians to fall into the trap of seeing the Word as a mechanical formula, instead of a personal representation of the Person of God. Our confidence and expectation must lie in our trust of the God we intimately know. Our dependency is rooted in understanding His absolute love and faithfulness towards us. Not a mechanical formula. When we give ourselves to God's Word, we give ourselves to truly knowing Who He is. This is where we see that His ways are perfect and His promises are true - we fall in love with Him and His Word. Loving and embracing God through His Word begins a transformation process in us from

the inside out. We are changed by knowing Him. Our thoughts become influenced by His thoughts (His Word), as do our attitudes, our words, and our actions.

So now, when we speak words of faith, they aren't just empty recitations, or wishful declarations, they are full of power because we speak from lives that have been Divinely influenced by our relationship with the Word Himself.

I earnestly encourage you to take the time to purposefully give yourself to God's Word this week. Each day determine to find out more about Him as you spend time meditating on its truth. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the Person of Jesus to you and make His Words come alive in your heart, so that the transformation process can begin inside you.

As you delight in His Word, you'll delight in Him and His ways. This is where He places His pure and wonderful desires for your good in your heart and mind, so you can walk in them. Psalms 37:4 says, ***"Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He will give you the desires and secret petitions of your heart."***

How God Rewards Our Suffering

I don't know anyone who gets excited about going through hardship, and yet it's unavoidable in everyone's life at some time or other. When trouble comes, a natural response is "Why is this happening?" or "I can't believe this is happening to ME!"

But the Bible tells us that hard times are actually good for us. James 1:2-3 (AMP) says, ***"Consider it nothing but joy...whenever you fall into various trials. Be assured that the testing of your faith [through experience] produces endurance [leading to spiritual maturity, and inner peace]."***

These verses are saying that we can learn to go through hard times with joy and hope, knowing God will use them to make us better in the end.

Resist the Urge to Run

When things get tough, our initial reaction is to want to run from the pain and escape the situation, but what we need to do is take a firm stand in our faith and face it. Jesus promises us in John 16:33 that if we will trust Him in the midst of the struggle, we can have peace and confidence that we will overcome it because He is on our side!

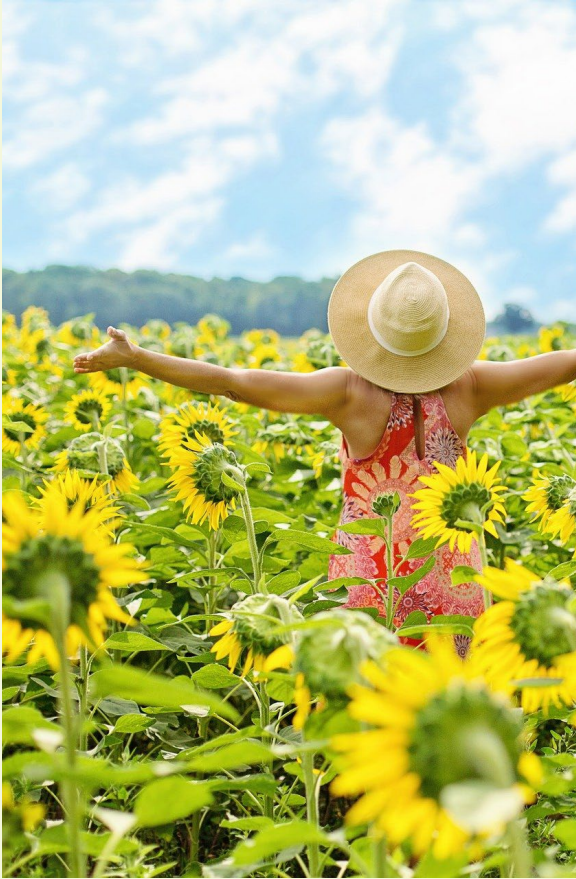
Now, we don't just overcome the problem, but in the process of going through it, God uses the very thing that is causing our pain to develop endurance, patience and perseverance in our soul. This is how we build our faith in God and grow up spiritually.

The Value of Patience and Endurance

The Greek Dictionary says patience is a fruit of the Spirit that grows only under trial. In fact, the word patience comes from the root word hupone, which means "to remain under."

Patience has to do with being steadfast, disciplined and committed - not running from difficult things, but sticking with them all the way through. It's about having a good attitude while you're waiting for your breakthrough or the fulfillment of something you desire.

Patience has a lot to do with endurance. I've come up with my own definition of endurance: "to outlast the enemy." It reminds me not to give up when I'm weary because I never want to give in to the temptations Satan brings my way or let him win the battle.



We all get weary at times and wonder if we'll ever get our breakthrough when we've been fighting the same battles for a long time. But the ones who refuse to give up are the ones who will have a testimony in the end!

The Test of My Quality

In 1 Peter 4:12, we see that painful experiences test the quality of our faith. When our quality is tested, we learn things about ourselves, because we don't really know what we would do in a tough situation until we're in it. God allows us to go through hard times to reveal what's in our hearts.

I remember a season in my life when I was praying for God to change me and make me more patient, sweet, merciful and loving. He answered my prayer at the grocery store.

I used to be very impatient when it was time to check out at the supermarket, and I somehow managed to pick the slow line every time. I can vividly remember one day when there was a new clerk being trained and everything was taking longer than usual. I was frustrated, and I made sure they knew it! I sighed loudly and mumbled under my breath.

These times at the grocery store were tests meant to develop patience and endurance in my soul. Over time, as I continued to grow in my relationship with God, I began to pass these tests more often. I came to the point where I could wait in the slow line with a good attitude - without opening my mouth or making a sound.

The Reward Always Outweighs the Pain

My example of developing patience at the grocery store may seem trivial compared to the trial you're facing today. But I want to encourage you to find comfort in the truth that God is with you and He knows exactly what you're going through. He loves you more than you know, and He has the answers you desperately need.

There have been many times when I've walked through devastating pain, and Galatians 6:9 has been an encouragement to me. It says, **"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up"** (NIV).

And God promises in Romans 8:28 that if we will trust Him and keep doing what is right in each situation, He will work it all out for our good. He will take every moment of pain and use it to develop priceless fruit, such as love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control in our soul (Galatians 5:22-23).

That's more than enough reason to keep going, one day at a time, and to never give up!

Women:

The Great Commission Is Your Permission

I want to open up this topic of gender prejudice by stepping back to a time when the church was new-born, alive and growing after the resurrection, and there was an outpouring of God's Spirit on both sons and daughters. The gospel was being released in both word and deed as the resurrection of Jesus was proclaimed. Panicked temple leaders, in an attempt to calm the storm, arrested Peter and John when a man who had been lame for forty years was healed!

They called them back and warned them that they were on no account ever again to speak or teach in the name of Jesus. (Acts 4:18 Message)

The "they" in this interaction refers to the religious leaders of their day, and Peter and John are the ones who were sternly warned. This wonder performed in the name of Jesus, the healing of a man, had thrown wide open a door to preach Christ the risen Savior. The Jewish leaders found themselves between a rock and a hard place because there was no denying the healing of this crippled man. They reasoned among themselves:

By now it's known all over town that a miracle has occurred, and that they are behind it. There is no way we can refute that. But so that it doesn't go any further, let's silence them with threats so they won't dare to use Jesus's name ever again with anyone. (Acts 4:16–17 Message)

We all know that threatening these two disciples did not work. If anything their tactics had the very opposite effect and actually strengthened their resolve.

But Peter and John spoke right back, ***"Whether it's right in God's eyes to listen to you rather than to God, you decide. As for us, there's no question - we can't keep quiet about what we've seen and heard."*** (Acts 4:18–20 Message)

As far as Peter and John were concerned, the religious leaders could continue to argue among themselves for as long as they liked, but they would not be stopped. They realized trying to convince these leaders would be an exercise in futility. They had no choice but to continue teaching and preaching what they knew to be true. These men understood that there are times when silence equates to disobedience.

These threats echo in our ears even today. The recipients of this threat look different now. This is no longer an isolated directive given by religious leaders to uneducated fishermen from Galilee. It has grown into a cultural push the world over. It sounds different now, but the objective is the same. Our secular world will allow you to talk about God and be as spiritual as you like, just as long as you don't use the name of Jesus.

And though we should not be surprised when secular arenas block teaching and preaching in the name of Jesus, when the church obstructs its members and silences their voices...well, that is another animal entirely.

For more than two millennia religious leaders have limited and at times prohibited thousands of the church's daughters from preaching and teaching in the sacred spaces under its governance. Read Acts 4:18 again:

So they called them and charged them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus.

As I pondered this verse, I heard the Holy Spirit whisper, *"Far too many of the daughters I called and gifted by my Spirit for ministry have been held back and denied their call by the church."*

You might have heard religious leaders say, *"Women can teach other women but not men."* Or, *"Women can share, but there is to be no preaching."* And: *"Women can lead, as long as it is outside the church."* These veiled threats appear to be more reasonable, but the result is the same: the gospel is contained. Women who are bold with their faith are too quickly labelled aggressive. Women who are confident in their God are mistaken for ambitious. Yet the question before us is the same one raised by Peter and John. Is it right in the sight of God to listen to men rather than to obey God? And what has God instructed both his sons and daughters to do? We find our answer in the words Jesus spoke right before he ascended:

"Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover." So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. (Mark 16:15–19)

This directive was given to all who believe. The Great Commission is permission, it doesn't even require a building or an organization, and this mandate is inclusive of both genders. In Christ all are called and liberated to declare God's good news. Once we've known God's freedom and truth we should never allow human threats to silence us.

Are You Built To Last?

The most important feature of any permanent structure is its foundation. That's because it's the foundation that determines the strength and stability of the building or lack thereof. With this in mind, Scripture often compares our lives to the construction of a building.

Paul wrote, ***"You are God's building... Because of God's grace to me, I have laid the foundation like an expert builder. Now others are building on it. But whoever is building on this foundation must be very careful"*** (1 Corinthians 3:9–10 NLT). Similarly, Jude wrote, ***"But you, beloved, build yourselves up on [the foundation of] your most holy faith [continually progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher]"*** (Jude 20 AMPC).

Throughout history, mankind has constructed remarkable structures with impeccable engineering and design that have left us awestruck. Numerous tourists travel around the globe to observe these man-made marvels. Among these wonders include the world's tallest building - the Burj Khalifa - which towers over Dubai.

Standing at an astonishing 2,717 feet, the Burj Khalifa is a sight to behold! With 163 floors, the Burj Khalifa includes a hotel, restaurants, residential

apartments, office spaces, and the longest single running elevator in the world (140 floors), which travels at a speed of 32 feet per second. To give you further perspective about this manmade marvel, it's approximately three times as tall as the Eiffel Tower and almost double the size of the Empire State Building.

As spectacular as the Burj Khalifa's external details are; what is even more impressive is the foundation! With the Burj Khalifa weighing approximately 450,000 tons, it's no wonder that the foundation runs 167 feet deep - that's the equivalent to 10 stories! The whole building is supported by a large reinforced concrete raft, which includes 192 bored concrete piles each having a diameter of 5 feet and a length of 141 feet respectively. That's a secure foundation!

Now, looking at our lives as God's building, it's important to note that just as builders follow a specific blueprint designed by engineers, beginning with the foundation phase - likewise, God (the Master Builder) has a specific blueprint and building design for our lives that can be found through studying and obeying His Word. Jesus taught:



Build your life with obedience to God's Word

“Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall”
(Matthew 7:24–27 NKJV).

A life built on God's Word is like a house built on a solid foundation - it is built to last! Both the wise man and the foolish man heard the Lord's teaching, but the wise man's obedience to the

Word that was heard is what made the difference. Likewise, when we build our life with obedience to God's Word, it ensures stability as we rise like a beautifully erected building. When we're grounded and shaped by God's Word, we'll stand firm when life's storms arise. Therefore, let's build wisely!

Then He said to them all, ***“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.”*** (Luke 9:23 NKJV). What does the cross stand for? It stands for death to self.

Last night my dear wife, Jill, and I watched a DVD about the life of the Olympic runner Eric Liddell, depicted in the famous movie *‘Chariots of Fire’*. After winning the gold medal at the Olympic Games in France, he laid all his glory down – the first Scotsman ever to win gold at The Olympic Games) – got onto a ship and headed for China as a missionary for Jesus!

Remember, he was the man who refused to run on the Sabbath, and the 100 meters was being run on Sunday. He was the fastest man in the world at that time and was virtually guaranteed to get a gold medal for Great Britain. Tremendous pressure was on him to run, even from the royal family, but he refused. So they enrolled him in the 400 meters, which he had not trained for...and he came first by a huge margin and set a new world record! Can't out bless the Lord!

But he gave it all up – the fame and the glory – and went to China as a servant of the Lord Jesus Christ. He died there at the age of 43.

What an amazing opportunity you and I have to live for others, just like Eric did. And indeed at a time such as this – with public morale at an all-time low and with the future looking so uncertain. It's the time for believers to shine for Jesus and to make a difference. Remember: our worst enemy is ourselves, not the devil. When we can die to self and start to live for our fellow man, then we start to live the abundant life Jesus speaks of in John 10:10.

Kathryn Kuhlman, the woman who was so powerfully used by God to heal the sick, once said: *if you're not feeling well, go and find someone else who is more sick than you are and pray for them and you won't feel so sick afterwards*. The point is, when you and I start to take the focus off ourselves and start living for others then everything changes – and we have the victory over depression, fear and anxiety. There are so many poor folks that need your love and prayers today.

Depression, anxiety, hopelessness, negativity; youth caught in a double-bind

Wheaton, Illinois – Youth are in serious trouble and no one seems to be addressing the reasons why. Suicide is the second leading cause of death among people aged 10-34. Depression, substance abuse and deteriorating mental health are exploding in a culture where many young people no longer believe in God. At a time when homosexuality is normalized, gay-identifying youth are four times more likely to commit suicide.

Dr. Rob Rienow has been studying youth and youth trends for two decades. He believes the waning belief in God, the crumbling American family, and disrespect for authority are major factors in much of the social breakdown we are witnessing. With 1



in 4 children growing up without a father, Rienow says this leaves youth hurt, depressed, and without a moral compass.



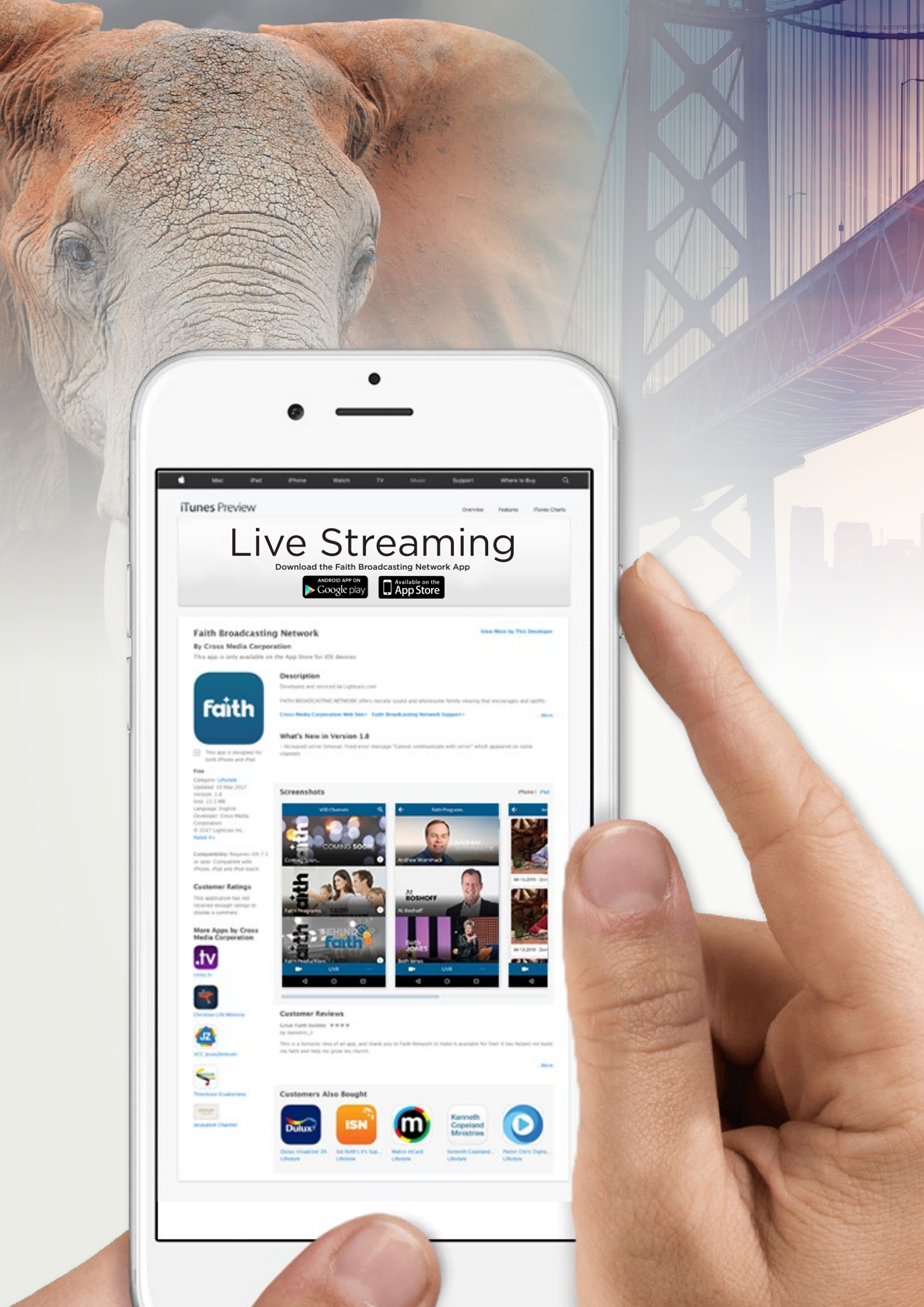
Rienow also says it is not the job of the church to disciple your children. He explains that parents have delegated the responsibility of spiritual growth and nurturance to churches and that it is clearly not working. ***“God created families to be discipleship centers,”*** says Dr. Rienow in *GENERATIONS: Following Jesus as a Family*. Ironically, a mere 1 in 20 families actually do anything that even closely resembles family worship. Throughout the Bible God uses the family to mirror what He wants to do in the society. He explains that families are under attack precisely because they are part of God’s plan for future generations.

As many disaffected youth riot in our cities and loot our neighborhoods, Rienow believes the core of the problem goes back to the family. He believes families have ***“abandoned the biblical model to pass faith on to their children.”*** This

paradigm shift which Dr. Rienow calls ***“delegation parenting”*** takes parents mostly out of the equation for training their own children. While there are many reasons for this shift, he encourages parents to renew their commitment to family.

The traditional family is under attack explains Rienow. ***“Our job is to pass our faith and values on to our children.”*** There is no more important place to establish a heart connection between parents and their children than within the family.

Family Times Of Connecting

DYNAMIS

Visiting various parts of the country, I become more and more aware how many different perspectives there are to see God and to perceive salvation and freedom - in a sense I find myself confronted with various "*religions*" within the Christian community. I am also confronted by the results of these perspectives in education in young people of school-leaving age. Truth be told, these young adults make decisions based on what they had been fed in mind and soul. As such I have a deep desire in my heart to make parents aware of the critical importance of their involvement during the growing years of their children.

While on a recent trip to Gauteng I visited friends, Jannie and Tertia Putter and their two children, and great was my surprise when Jannie took me into their garden and showed me a special "*place of connection*" he had made for his family. Jannie constructed a little covered wooden lapa within which he placed a black board with the family vision and prayer list surrounded by loose scatter cushions. He told me how they gather there and bond as a family and connect with God, participating early in the morning before their normal day routines start. Jannie pointed out how one of their visions of 2013 came true when they went for a ski holiday in Italy. They put their vision on the wall every year and work together as a family towards a plan for the whole year, giving them a sense of direction and belonging.

I could feel the vibrancy in their home, the connectedness, the warmth and excitement for life. I was encouraged and stirred up to share

this with you as I know many other families that are desperately lonely. Unless as Christians we encourage one another to do the simple God-things and give practical guidance on how to achieve these, many will remain in bondage of loneliness and despair.

Jannie mainly works in South African schools as a motivator for teachers and youth, and he shares some interesting facts with me:

- There are more children today with emotional problems like depression, anxiety, lack of motivation, desires to commit suicide, rebellion, sexual diseases, and addiction than ever before in history;
- In 1960 about 80% of young adults at the age of 30 was able to maintain a "*adult and mature*" life. Such a life implies that one is able to take care of yourself, a family and to be financially self-reliant. In the year 2000 this figure has dropped to a shocking 46% of young adults at the age of 30 years. This means that by the year 2000 about 54% of young adults were still living in their parent's homes, being financially dependent upon their parents;
- Modern life has changed at a rapid pace. We are living in an era of technology, pornography, suicides, divorce, cancer, steroids, pop-stars, social networks, television, I-pads, tablets, internet, Facebook, Whats-app and a non-stop stream of information available to anyone with a cell-phone or a computer;



- Statistics shows that the average teenager spends about 14 hours per week on a computer and about 12 hours in front of a television – more than ever before (because it was not available ever before);
- More than 25% of deaths amongst youth are the result of suicide;
- One out of three children between the ages of 12 and 17 in South Africa was involved in a sexual relationship;
- A shocking amount of youth abuses alcohol and most deaths on the road are alcohol-related;
- Alcohol is involved in most of youth-suicides;
- The amount of youth and teens struggling with emotional diseases has increased dramatically over the last decade;
- Statistics shows the probability that a youth before the age of 25 will have an emotional disease (e.g. depression, addiction, suicide-feelings) - this equates to 1 out of 3 people.

God says, **“He puts the lonely in the family”** (Psalm 68:6). What I gather from the above statistics is that family is the place where these matters need to be addressed.

Social interaction is essential for normal social and emotional development. Socialization is a deep emotional matter; hence children who feel needed, wanted, and depended upon at home are those who develop self-confidence and self-worth.

Lack of self-worth is a reason for increased peer dependency and dependency on others things like drugs, sex, smoking and unhealthy relationships. A child's degree of self-esteem is one of the best measurements of his ability to successfully interact socially.

“This pervasive idea that children are better socialized and adjusted if they are constantly surrounded by their peers is an extravagant myth. The child who has been taught at home, who feels needed and wanted, who knows he is dependent on at home, sharing responsibilities and chores is much more likely to develop a sense of self worth and a stable value system which is the basic ingredient for positive sociability” (Dr Raymond Moore).

All we hear today is that people have no time - no time to relax, to play or pray, to reflect, to exercise, and to do what is really necessary to live a balanced life. Where is all this taking society? Where are most of us heading? What are we all chasing after?

Our children spend most of their hours in school. But what happens in schools? The facts speak so loud we cannot ignore it! Loads and loads of work, all information with little understanding and little skills; it is more a case of *“keeping up with the Jones”* than actually focusing on educating children to be able to be skilled and mature leaders in society. Teachers have unfortunately lost their authority due to legislation and the common moral decay flooding every social system.

The only stable and reliable system we have today is the home as this is the place where morals and values are set in place. Every one of us has this power and ability in our hands - may we use it otherwise we will lose it! My suggestion is that families get together, even if only once a week, and pray. Let it be a good, positive connection time, a place of belonging, of safety and a time to come before the Father. ***We are all sons and daughters of God, through faith in Jesus*** (Galatians 3:26). We are not just parents, but we are also fellow believers with our children.

Why The Christian Community's Desire To Physically Assemble Falls on Deaf Ears

As we move into the back stretch of this pandemic, there's been a massive debate about church congregations being able to fully re-assemble in a physical building - particularly in the most restricted states.

And even within the Christian community there are a wide range of legitimate opinions and strategies from Andy Stanley's reasons he's keeping Northpoint Community Church closed until 2021 to John MacArthur's recent statement about his decision to defy California's ban on church gatherings. There are reasonable arguments on both sides, and I'm not taking sides here. However, as we enter the sixth month of the lockdown in California, a growing number of pastors believe that it's time to allow churches to make their own decisions – not the state.

Outside the church community, that desire has fallen on deaf ears as evidenced by the Supreme Court ruling that turned down a request by a

Nevada church for permission to hold services on the same terms that other facilities in the state, including casinos, that are allowed to hold gatherings during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Although different states have different rules, it's pretty clear that when churches are either closed or severely restricted while airlines are packed, casinos can operate, and massive protests are praised in the media, something has dramatically changed in the culture.

The most common arguments for keeping churches closed during the pandemic is the question "What positive impact do churches make on society?"

I've seen that question asked over and over on social media, with politicians, and in media interviews, which means: **In today's culture, a church's impact isn't measured by its theological position, doctrinal statement, or**



it's style of worship, but by what can be seen by the outside world.

When it comes to visible impact, I have to say that the vast majority of churches are invisible.

And if the world doesn't see any clear, visible evidence of the impact a local church makes, then they see little reason to keep it open during a pandemic, or during any other crisis.

And not to be dramatic, but if that invisibility goes on too long, there will come a time when they won't have difficulty deciding a church has no value at all, should lose its tax exempt status, and eventually be closed altogether.

Theology is important. Doctrine is important. Evangelism is important. But in a secular age, the world will measure our value based on what we do, not what we believe.

And before you get upset and think I'm trying to water down our message, remember that was exactly the strategy of the Early Church. As Jonathan Bock and I wrote in our book *"The Way Back: How Christians Blew Our Credibility and How We Get It Back,"* the Early Church had no power, influence, funding, or support. They were illegal throughout most of the Roman Empire, hunted down, and persecuted. They had no authority or ability to criticize the government, defy the Romans, or plead their cause.

So they decided to be the people Jesus called us to be.

As a result, when the plague hit the empire, while rich Romans ran for the hills, Christians ran to the hardest hit areas and ministered to people they didn't know at the risk of their own lives.

Early Christians despised the common Roman practice of infanticide but had no power to stop

it. So they made the decision to find abandoned newborns, bring them into their families, and raise them as their own children.

They honored and elevated the role of women in their communities and made the commitment to abstain from sex outside of marriage.

I could go on and on, but you get the picture.

The unexpected actions of those early believers baffled the Romans, and the impact was remarkable.

Historians today report that it was the behavior of these earliest believers that began changing the attitudes of the non-believing public, and was a major reason the Roman Empire eventually became Christian in a remarkably short time.

What's the lesson for today? The single greatest reason the secular culture could care less about the Church re-opening is that they don't see the value.

But what if our invisible Church suddenly became visible again? What if helping those in need, feeding the hungry, assisting the vulnerable, restoring families, and getting people back to work became our battle cry? Whether they believe the gospel or not, what if the world saw such a powerful positive impact on local communities they couldn't imagine what life would be like without the Christian community?

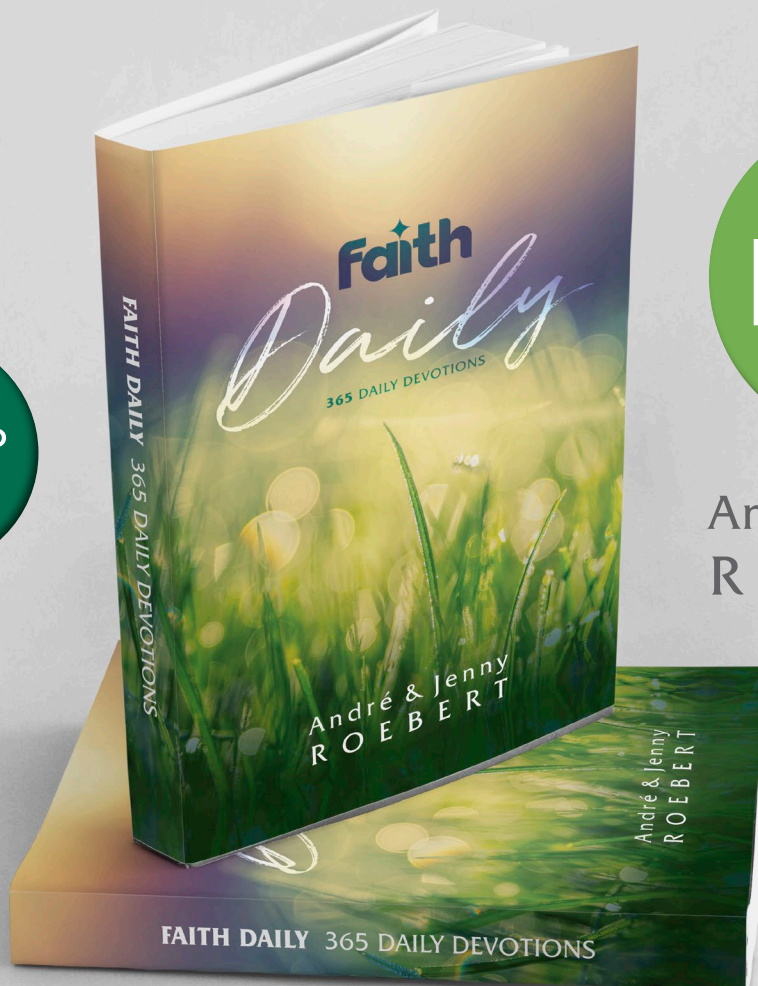
Who knows? It might be the unbelievers who start working hardest to open church doors again.
