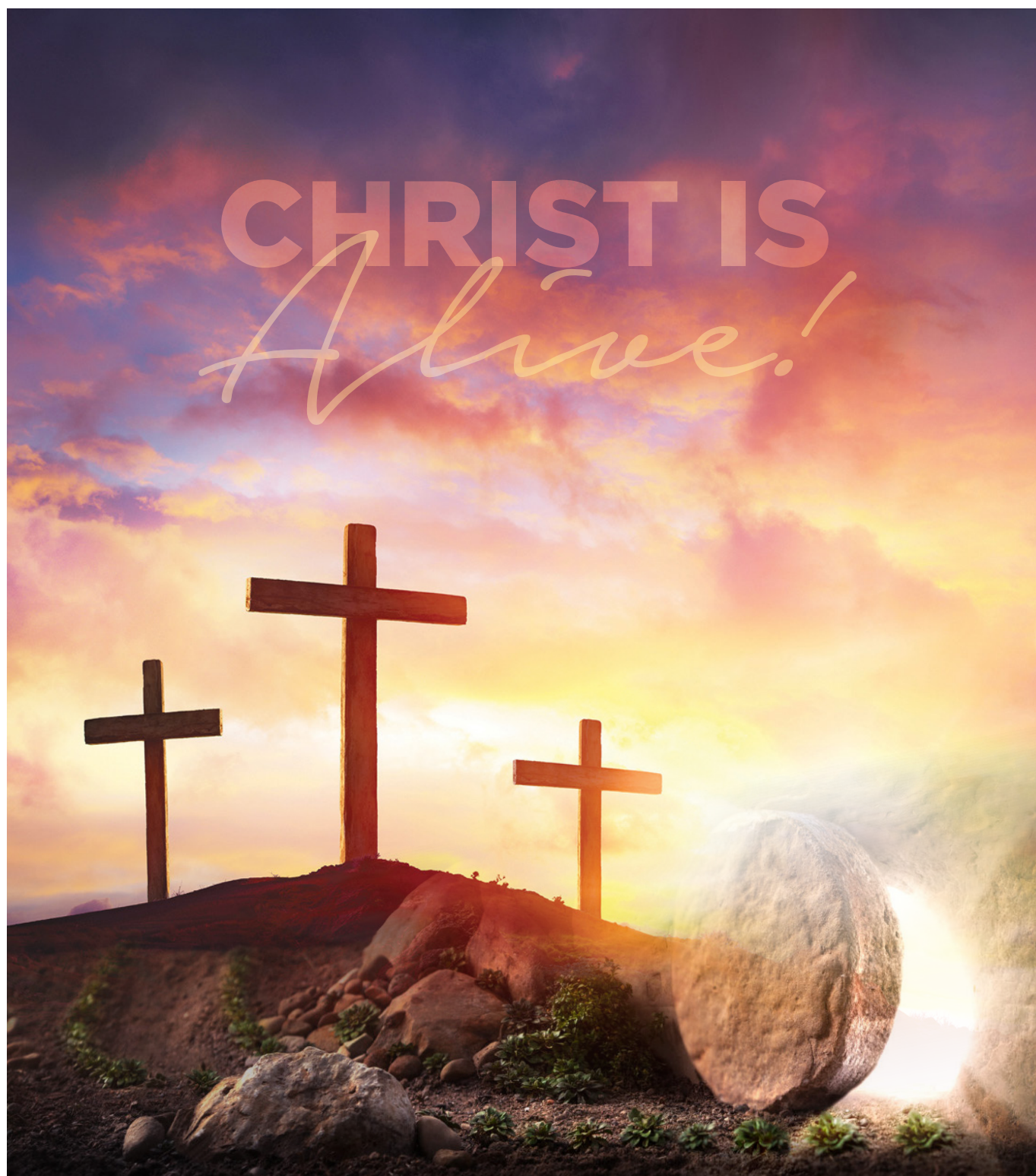

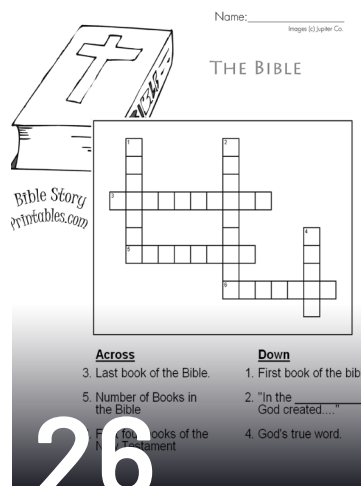

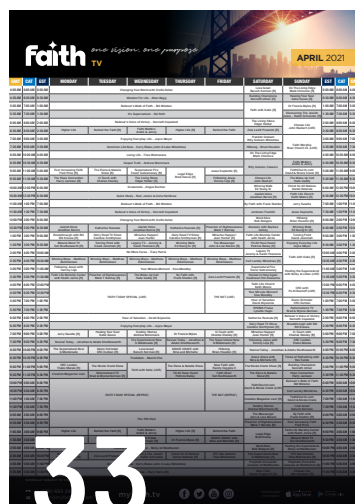

LIVING RIGHTEOUSLY

Deuteronomy 16:20 says, "Follow what is altogether just (uncompromisingly righteous), that you may live and inherit the land which your God gives you."

THE KEY TO BEING TRULY CONTENT

It seems there are very few people who are consistently content with life. It's more common to be up and down mentally and emotionally, depending on what our circumstances are.

So I want to ask you: How content are you? Are you consistently enjoying your life?

In the book of Philippians, the apostle Paul not only teaches about the importance of having the joy Jesus gives, but he says that he learned ***“how to be content (satisfied to the point where I am not disturbed or disquieted) in whatever state I am”*** (Philippians 4:11 AMP). And it was a life-changing revelation for me when I understood that my joy and contentment don't have to be based on my circumstances.

What does it mean to really be content?

Being content doesn't mean you never want anything to change or to have anything else in your life. It means you can be satisfied to wait with a good attitude for whatever God chooses to do in your life. It means that even when you want something to happen, you still trust God enough to believe that if He doesn't give you what you want, He has your best interest at heart. And you'll find that what He gives you is better than what you thought you wanted to begin with.

The world is full of problems and we all have times when things don't go the way we planned. So it's

wonderful when you get to the point that you can be happy even when you don't get your way!

I've learned that since the world probably isn't going to change, then I need to change my approach to circumstances - my attitude and my expectations. And it was a great breakthrough for me when I discovered that God wants me to have great expectations of Him. He wants me to put all of my hope in Him and exercise my faith in Him to do great things in my life.

What does God want to do for you?

Ephesians 3:20 says that God's power that is working in us ***“is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]”*** (AMP). I love these words: superabundantly, far over and above ALL that we dare to ask or think!

It's so important for us to put our expectations in the right place - in God. We serve an awesome God, and I want to encourage you to ask Him to do great things in you and through you.



What are you asking God to do for you? Do you believe He loves you unconditionally and He has great plans for you? Do you trust Him to take care of your needs and that everything He asks you to do is for your good?

We need to resist thinking that God can't do anything for us because of our weaknesses and faults. He isn't expecting us to be perfect; He wants us to have faith in Him.

God wants us to put ALL of our hope and ALL of our expectation in Him. He wants us to trust Him to do what's best for us in the way He chooses to do it. He wants us to give Him the credit for the good things He does in our lives.

Are you putting your expectation in God?

Sometimes we are discontent and disappointed because we think we're expecting something from God but in reality, we're expecting someone else to give it to us. For example, we pray for a raise or promotion and don't get it so we get mad at our boss. Or we ask God to make our children behave better or our spouse to be more sensitive and thoughtful and when they don't do what we want, we get mad at them.

We need to look to God to provide what we need and what we want. This means we trust Him, no matter what other people do or what circumstances look like. It's not wrong to put realistic expectations in the people we have relationships with, but no one is perfect, and people will disappoint us sometimes.

We can get rid of a lot of disappointment and discontentment by learning how to put our hope and expectation in God first and foremost.

God cares about everything about you and everything that concerns you. He wants to be good to you and He will never disappoint you. Give Him all of your heart and put all of your hope and expectation in Him. You can have true contentment and satisfaction in Christ!

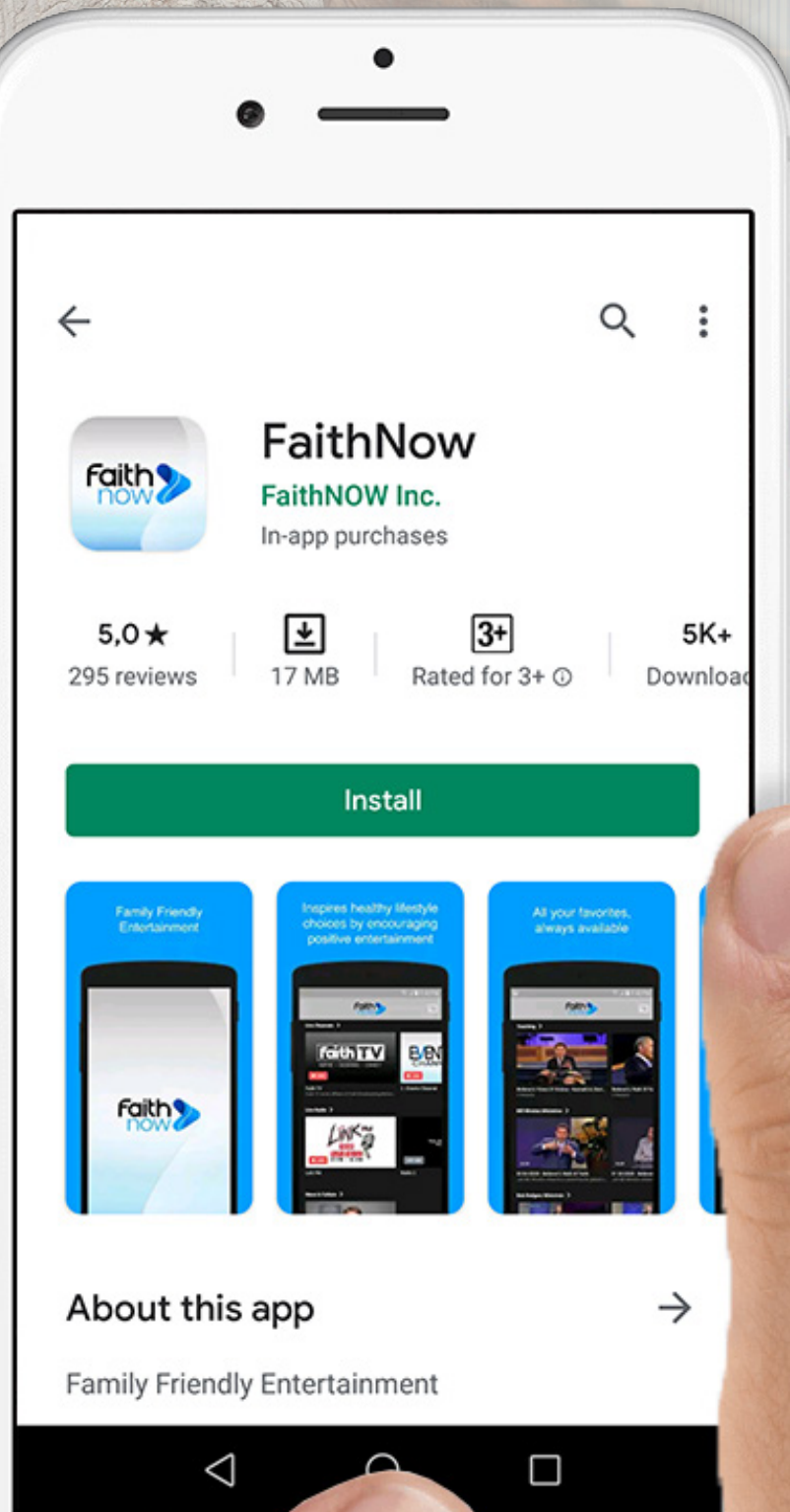
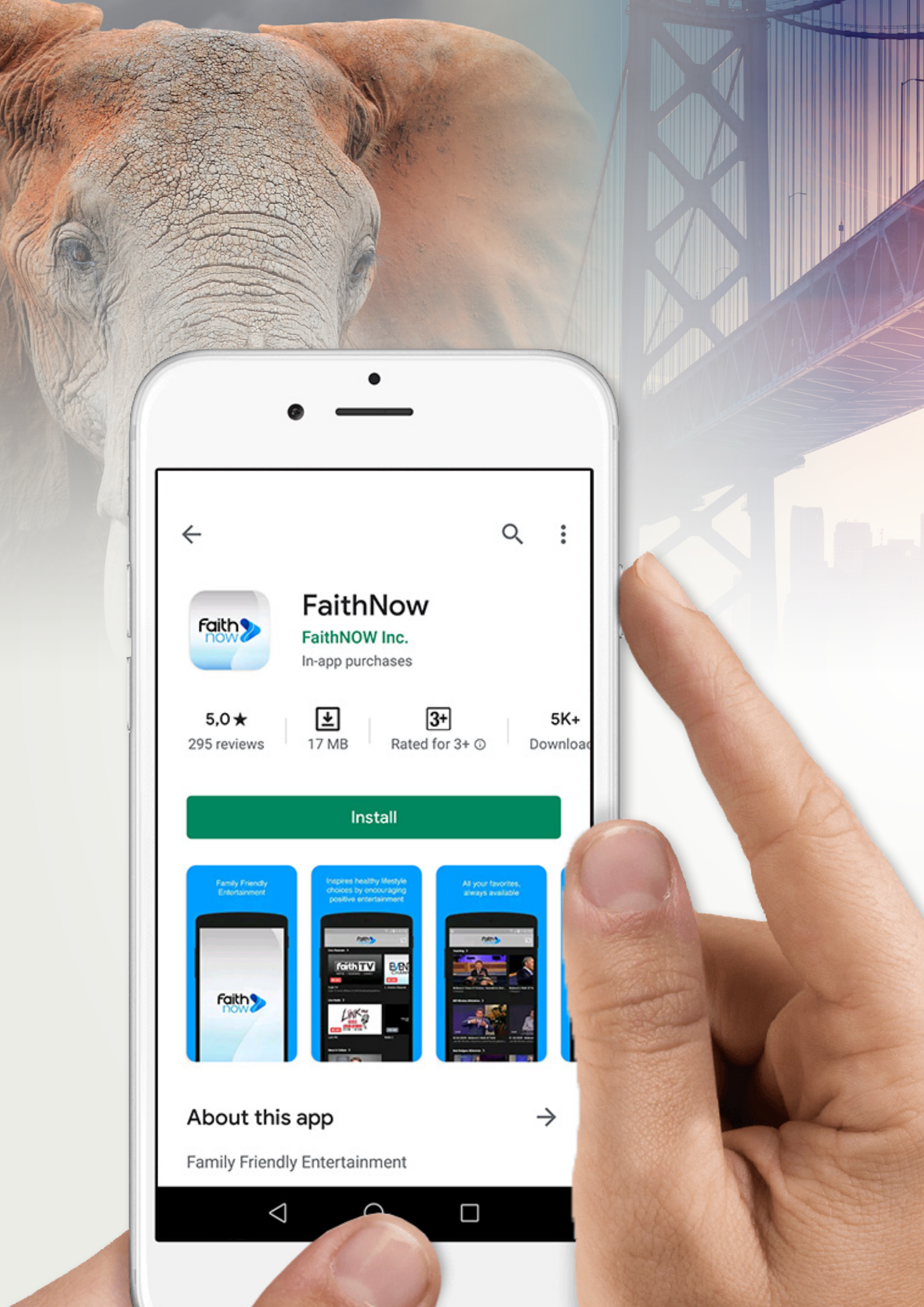
But I meet people regularly who have a new project, a new job, or new relationship. And when

HOW TO DEAL WITH THE WHINERS ON YOUR TEAM

Most creative teams are going to have at least one member who's a whiner. Whiner's focus on the negative, and thrive on complaining – often about the most insignificant things you can imagine.

According to the Wall Street Journal, research indicates that productivity can be damaged by working alongside a chronic complainer.

Exposure to non-stop negativity can disrupt learning, memory, attention, and judgement. The problem is more widespread than you think, because in many cases, it's become so commonplace that we don't even notice anymore.

If you're a leader, you can confront them, but if you're a co-worker, it's much more difficult. So if you can't walk away easily, here are some key techniques for dealing with a whiner:

1) Get away from them. Move your desk and if possible, change your office. Just the geographic change can make a significant difference. Most of the time, whiners vent on who's nearby, so don't be an easy target.

2) Switch the conversation. Ask them opposite questions, like: What's working? What's going well? Turn the talk to good things about the company or project, and you can often derail the whiner.

3) Put them on the spot. Ask them what they intend to do about the problem. Don't be a jerk, but be direct. Agree with them that what they're whining about is a real problem, but something has



to be done. What do they suggest? That's usually enough to stop the whiner in his or her tracks.

4) Let them know you're not interested. Once they hit a brick wall enough times, they'll look for someone else. So if nothing else works, get in their face. Again, don't be rude, but be honest. Tell them you don't think being negative will solve the problem, and when they have another idea then you'll listen.

5) Leaders: Consider scheduling times to vent. If you can book the occasional meeting where employees have a designated time to complain (and be listened to), this will often get it out of their system. Employees do have challenges, and as

leaders we too often don't take it seriously. Just the act of listening can make a huge difference.

Enough positive employees can overwhelm the negative, so teach your team the power of engaging the negative with positive responses, and suddenly the futility of just complaining will become very clear.

THERE IS BEAUTY IN THE WOUNDS AND THERE IS VICTORY IN THE SCARS

John 20:27 (HCSB): Then He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and observe My hands. Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Don't be an unbeliever, but a believer."

The aftermath of the bad events that happened in our lives can sometimes leave us scarred for life. Consequently, in the cosmetic glorified society, some people may feel a sense of stigma attached to their scars and will try every means to hide them or possibly consider surgery to permanently get rid of them.

There is an incorrect notion that conceptualizes scars as having the ability to either remind us of our past suffering or a constant reminder for old wounds. Although scars may have some negative implications to them, when viewed positively they can bring about a confident narration. Especially in instances where some people are not ashamed

to reveal their scars but use the opportunity to publicly display them so that they can share with others their stories of healing and deliverance from past pain and wounds.

For instance, I once heard a testimony of Dave Roevers, USA Navy Veteran, who was tragically injured in the Vietnam War, when a phosphorous grenade blew up in his hand. The blast left parts of his body permanently damaged. He suffered third-degree burns and was burned beyond recognition. The one thing that captivated me about his story was seeing how courageous he still remains even after having a near-death experience. Even though he is still covered with scars, Dave is a picture of

a man who's conquered death. If you can have eyes that can see past his scars and receive the message of hope he brings through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, you'll begin to unbosom a warrior. Dave uses the very same scars to point us to this truth that God still heals, and that scars are simply testimonies of our victory and the innate power we have to overcome.

People like Dave who do not mind being vulnerable, normally tell their stories with the hope to heal others and also to be witnesses to those who do not yet believe, that God can make beauty out of ashes. That there is an embedded message of victory in every pain and sorrow, in each and every one of us!

This man, Dave, reminded me of a similar incident that happened more than 2000 years ago, when the son of man, Jesus, was beaten beyond recognition, hanged on a cross and left to die. He endured pain like a soldier. Jesus Christ is our perfect example of the man who conquered death, hell and the grave. The Word of God described that dreadful event in the book of Isaiah 52:14 when it declared, that the Messiah would suffer intense pain to a point where he'll lose physical form. It further explains that He would be unrecognizable to many. We witnessed this firsthand in the Gospel books on how this prophecy came to pass... As four different authors narrate a story on how the Son of God suffered, how He died and rose again in victory.

God knows pain; that is why He can then sympathise with us. He is aware of the scars we carry. For this very reason, He allowed His Son to be pierced by the sword. He allowed Him to be detached from His presence and die.

When Jesus made His public appearance after His resurrection to the disciples, He wasn't ashamed to be seen with scars all over His body. He wasn't worried about His physical form. He didn't hide behind a glorious robe. But He boldly stood in front of them because He was glad that He defeated the enemy and fulfilled the will of God. He was glad that he completed the mission – to redeem mankind back to God – and was now ready to be glorified. He showed Thomas all His scars and commanded him to touch and feel them for himself, so that he can have faith enough to believe in the resurrection power. Thomas was astonished because he realised that those scars were symbols of victory, confirming that the battle is being won.

You see, there is a hidden message of beauty in His wounds. For every pain that He had to endure and every drop blood that was shed, Jesus Christ was paying the punishment that we deserved. The Word says that His wounds redeemed us from the curse of diseases, iniquities and sorrows so that we can access the blessing. The book of Isaiah 53:5 says, ***“But He was pierced because of our transgressions, crushed because of our iniquities; the punishment for our peace was on Him, and we are healed by His wounds.” (HCSB) He revoked the bill of punishment that we deserved and placed us in a position of victory by giving us His righteousness. 1 Peter 2:24 declares, “He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, so that, having died to sins, we might live for righteousness; you have been healed by His wounds.” (HCSB)***

Wounds that go untreated can cause wounded people to be volatile, full of rage and end up hurting others; whilst hidden scars can become baggage of guilt, condemnation and shame. But Jesus Christ's compassion to Thomas teaches us that showing others our scars can build their faith. He let Thomas see His side, the deepest scar, showing him His love, when Thomas was weak to believe the good news... He showed him His hands that were nailed so that the message of victory will be proclaimed.

Many people spend money trying to fix the outside appearances, instead of allowing Jesus Christ to mend their inner wounds and restore them back to divine health and wholeness. The finished work of the Cross and the resurrection power gives us the assurance that whatever ailments, whatever condition, whatever pain, whatever scar we carry, in Jesus we can overcome.

Paul, although considered one of the prominent apostles, wasn't ashamed to tell his followers of the suffering he endured that gave him several scars; instead, he felt strengthened by sharing about these so that he can glorify God. In 2 Corinthians 11:30, Paul says, ***“If I must boast, I will boast of the things that show my weakness.”*** (ESV) He himself had endured pain on many levels, that wounded him deeply, yet his faith was intact. In 2 Corinthians 11:24-26 he mentioned that five times he received from the Jews thirty-nine lashes; he was beaten by the Romans three times with rods. Once he received a stoning. At one point, he suffered a shipwreck. He had his fair share of trouble and suffering; working hard; having sleepless nights; in hunger and thirst, many times without food; in the cold and without enough clothing. Yet his faith never failed.

I believe for every wounded soul, there is a story of victory engraved in it. The only thing that would keep us from telling our stories and having mature faith is when we would hide our wounds and scars. But when we allow the Great Physician, Jesus Christ, to do a refining work in our lives, we can indeed come out of His surgery with marks that tell a story of victory and faith that stood the test of time. Just like Paul, we can unashamedly say, ***“I bear the marks of Jesus!”***
