



# CAN WE SEE GOD?

**John 14:21 (AMPC) says, "The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. [I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.]"**

What a powerful scripture! Jesus promises to reveal Himself to us, to let Himself be clearly seen by us, and make Himself real to us. Isn't this the cry of all our hearts? Well, according to this verse - it's a promise we can certainly experience. And not just when our bodies die and our spirits go to heaven, but now, while we are here, living on earth!

Obviously the question we need answered is how? How, on earth, do we get to see Jesus this way? Well, the first part of this piece of scripture tells us quite clearly doesn't it? It all has to do with God's Word abiding so strongly in us, that we begin to know and experience His overwhelming love for and in us. This is where we get to see Jesus.

Let's back up a little to John 15:7, where Jesus speaks about His Word abiding, or living in our hearts.

John 15:7 says, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you."

I believe this verse holds the key for us to see Jesus and walk in the fullness of life and victory Jesus secured for us, through the finished work of the cross. It sheds critical light on how our relationship with God's Word directly affects our relationship with Him and the influence this relationship has on our prayers - when we pray from this place of abiding!

In our previous letter I began explaining the transformation process we experience when we choose to abide in Jesus - the Living Word; and have His Words continually live inside us.



Today, I want to go a little deeper in explaining this process, showing you how the Word of God, when embraced, becomes a surgical tool in the hands of the Holy Spirit - to the place where the eyes of our hearts are wide open to see God.

Hebrews 4:12 says, "For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart."

Oh, I can't tell you how much I love this verse, it holds such weighty truth! You can't but shudder at the authority it credits to the word

of a God being alive in our hearts. That's why it's essential for us to hold God's word in such high regard. It is alive and full of power to go to work on the inside of every believer and transform our very nature, at its core.

It's that same seed of God's incorruptible word that was supernaturally planted within our spirits the moment we accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour of our lives. It began its transforming work the instant we received and embraced it! That work was so powerful it snatched us out of the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of light in an instant!

Can you just imagine what it can do in and to us if we continue to let it dwell in us richly? Oh my, I can, because scripture tells us exactly what it can and will do, if we fully open our lives to it:

2 Corinthians 3:18 says, "And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendour and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit."

There it is - the power of God's Word allows us to clearly see the glory of God. We see the very nature of God: His goodness, His kindness, His faithfulness, His mercy, His awesome power, His majesty, His indescribable beauty. The true nature of God is revealed as a reflection when we look deeply, with open, eager hearts into His Word.

Now, because His Holy Spirit is doing the revealing, what we learn

and see goes beyond mere knowledge. We don't just learn about the nature of God when His Word comes alive in us - we experience Him! We actually encounter Him in His word.

And it's when we do, we are changed, one glorious degree at a time into His very own image. And it's not just a small degree of change - it's a continuous, ever increasing degree of splendour, from glory to glory! All done by His Spirit Who lives inside us!

You'll recognise the process of this transformation the instant the word becomes life to you. It's as though the light was switched on in your soul, and you see and understand something with more than just in your mind, your spirit actually leaps with joy at the truth that has reached its home in you.

You actually feel so connected to the Lord and alive in Him at that very moment. You actually feel Him in that truth because you experience everything the Word says His Presence is.

The spontaneous joy, the pleasure and delight, the peace, the unfailing hope, His overwhelming love - all of it abounding at the same time, rushing up like a powerful fountain inside you. This is where the Holy Spirit reveals God to us, in His Word.

For me, this is where I know, without a shadow of a doubt, He is alive in me, He is with me, He is for me, and He is EVERYTHING His word says He is to me! It's when I know I'm completely rooted in Him, and every worry, every concern, every fear pales in comparison to the confidence and faith I have in Jesus and His incorruptible Word that's alive and dwelling in me - all in that moment.

So what does this have to do with what we can believe God for in prayer? Well, everything! You see, experiencing Jesus in His word like this, where your confidence and faith is so real and great - that's when you begin to pray from inside the throne room of God! That's when you begin to declare His word with true power and authority from a position of being seated in heavenly places with Him!

That's when every word you pray resonates with the Spirit of God - as though He is praying through you. You can literally sense each word going out with such power that the very atmosphere around you is charged and there is no doubt that it's producing exactly what its declaring in the spirit realm as well as the natural - hallelujah!

Why? Because we are praying in and on the authority of the Living, revealed Word of God! Against this - nothing can withstand!

When Jesus said, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you." ; He gave us a key that will unlock the reality of living in the fullness of life and victory He paid the price for us to enjoy.

# MAKE CHOICES THAT DON'T WASTE YOUR TIME

**God wants us to continually make good choices for our lives. So He's given us the Bible—His Word—as an instruction book to live by. The thing is, once we know what it says, we're responsible to do what it says. Because there's never a time when it's all right to do the wrong thing.**

As we study God's Word, we discover wisdom that applies to every area of our lives. And the best thing we can do is promptly obey God when He brings correction or direction to us. But there are times when we make bad choices anyway, and we experience the pain of our mistakes.

God is our Father, and just as earthly parents discipline their children to keep them from harm and help them see what is in their best interest, God sometimes requires us to face the consequences of our disobedience.

It's important to understand that when God corrects us, it's not because He's mad at us, but because He loves us. And if we follow His instructions, then we're going to have a life that's full of peace, joy, and emotional stability.

God cares about every area of our lives and He wants to be involved in everything we do. He wants to help us make good choices in how we dress, what we eat, who we hang out with, how we spend our money . . . about everything in our life.

Even if you have a lot of areas where you need to change and grow, you don't have to feel discouraged. As you become more

deeply rooted in God's love, it gets easier to do what He asks because you know He has your best interests at heart.


The question is: Do you value His opinion? Will you allow Him to continually work in your life?

When you really love Jesus, you're committed to righteousness. You want to do the right thing because it's right...because you love Him, not just to try to earn God's love or a reward from Him.

The good news is we never have to worry about earning God's love. Romans 5:8 says, "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." God loved us before we were born again and made the righteousness of God in Christ (see 2 Corinthians 5:17, 21). He'll always love us, and we don't have to wonder, Am I doing enough?

The truth is, you are not responsible for the results. God is responsible for that. Your responsibility is to keep doing the right thing all the time, no matter what.

It isn't always easy, but it's always worth it. There are going to be times when we'd rather do the wrong thing. But we'll just regret it



later. We need to decide that no matter what our circumstances look like or how hard doing the right thing might be, we're going to hold on to our joy because our joy is in Jesus.

Here's a practical example of what I'm saying: Even if I lose my job and the car breaks down and my child comes home with a bad report from school and I've gained five pounds and nothing seems to be working out in my life...even then, I will "rejoice in the Lord always" (Philippians 4:4). Even then, I will do what is right before the Lord.

We don't have to settle for letting our circumstances determine the level of our joy and peace. We can decide today: I'm going to continue doing right whether it's easy or not, and I'm going to trust God to give me the grace to do it.

When you're in the middle of hard times and you really don't like your circumstances, the first place to run is God's Word because it has the power to calm you down. Find scriptures about the

strength we have in Christ, and then just rest in God's presence and receive His strength. Whatever you need, just go to God's Word.

I've seen God do amazing things in me and through me because I've let Him continually work in my life—and you can have that kind of relationship, too.

I encourage you to pray like this: "God, today I'm giving You permission to keep working in my life until You are finished doing all that You need to do. So when I start begging You to back off, please don't. The truth is, I want to do whatever You are calling me to do."

Your relationship with God can be an amazing journey that brings you peace, joy and contentment in every area of life, if you will simply choose to follow Him.

**The Word of God in 2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV) says,

We as believers need to keep a calm demeanour and attitude towards the circumstances in which we are finding ourselves today. You see, if I had panicked with my horse Snowy, he would have sensed it straight away and it would have got much worse.

But I did not panic; I relaxed, I reassured him, he settled down and we continued with our ride.

Stay away from negative people who have got only negative reports. Start getting closer to Jesus and spending more time in the Word and you will find that your fear will be replaced by faith. That is what the world is desperately looking for in these last days. We have a great obligation, first of all to the Lord as His ambassadors.

2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV) tells us, “Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God”). Then, we also have an obligation to one another to keep our eyes fixed on the Lord and by so doing, bring peace into any situation in which we find ourselves. Whether it be in the workplace, on the sports field, in the home...we need to remember that nothing can happen to us without God's permission. God is in full control; He is never caught unaware.

# YOU'RE NOT TOO OLD – YOU'RE JUST BEGINNING!

Winston Churchill had pursued many options in his career, but he always wanted the ultimate job – Prime Minister of England. He had been a soldier, war correspondent, and had a number of political positions he had won and lost. He was doubted by many, and most people don't know that by the age of 40 he was considered a failure.

He became the First Lord of the Admiralty during World War I, and was the lead architect and supporter of the invasion of Turkey now known as the Gallipoli campaign. His goal is very strategic – create a southern link to England's ally at the time, Russia. But the Turks refused to give up and the campaign cost many lives. While Churchill wasn't totally responsible for the loss, the battle was a major defeat and it damaged his future prospects. For many, he was written off and forgotten.

But he never gave up, and by 1940, Hitler's Wehrmacht was moving across Western Europe, moving into position to sweep across the English Channel. That's when Churchill was summoned by King George VI to become prime minister and lead the British

forces against the greatest threat in nine centuries.

At the time, Winston Churchill was 65 years old. Despite the legion of critics and skeptics, he was confident. He said later that he felt he was "walking with destiny, and that all my life had been but a preparation for this hour and for this trial."

You know the rest. He was successful in not only reviving the British war effort, but persuading Roosevelt to bring the might of the United States to bear on the Nazis. He's been called the greatest leader of the 20th century, and the greatest British leader of all time.




And what put him on the map didn't happen until after turning 65.

# WHY THE POST-COVID CHURCH MAY SURPRISE YOU

There's no question that the year-long church shutdown because of the COVID-19 virus changed a lot about doing church.

Pastors who had never taken live-streaming seriously were suddenly asking about video cameras and the best streaming platforms. Pastors who had never looked twice at social media started connecting regularly with their followers. In the last 12 months I've personally taught more than 1,000 pastors from around the world how to make online worship services more effective.

But the conversation at the forefront of church leaders today is "What will church look like after COVID?" When this is all over for good, will things change? The good news is that pastors and church leaders discovered two important themes over the last year:

1. Church doesn't just happen in a building. It happens anywhere and anytime.
2. Instead of spending so much money and effort getting the

community to come to the church, maybe it's time the church went to the community.

Which brings me to what I think is about to happen in churches around the world:

**First – Live-streaming has changed everything and will continue.** Certainly we want to meet physically, but we've discovered that we can have small groups made up of people around the world, not just in our neighborhood. We've discovered that people can enjoy worship online. And we've discovered people will continue to support the church financially – even when they're not in the building.

**Second – Sunday services are about to undergo a shakeup.** I'm talking to numerous pastors who have no intention of going back into the building every week. Instead, they'll connect online at least 2 Sundays a month, and then physically meet once

or twice a month. But those physical meetings will be more like a “boot camp” where believers get far more serious about seeking God.

### **Third – Churches are moving into the communities.**

Churches across the country are becoming COVID vaccination centers. Some churches (like The Dream Center in Los Angeles) have been a vital link for food, paper supplies, and other necessities during the shutdown. Baptist churches across Texas stepped up during the recent freezing temperatures to help deliver food and water. We’re about to shift from “church” being all about a building, to “church” being all about the community.

### **Fourth – Churches will never look at the government the same way again.**

Pastors happily went the extra mile when politicians asked them to shut down for a period, but when it went on for months and months, we knew something was up. Over and over governors and mayors had no problem with people loitering in shopping malls, or packing into casinos, but they kept churches

closed. If you don’t think we live in a secular society, then it’s time to think again. Moving forward, we must be more vigilant than ever to protect our right to worship.

### **Finally – We know that the best way to protect that right is to become “essential” to our communities.**

Far too many churches have devolved into social gatherings where like-minded people enjoy each other and make no effort beyond the doors. But to make a real impact we need to become a blazing fire that changes the world. It’s time we re-kindled the New Testament church passion – not just for evangelism and sharing the story of Jesus – but for ministering to every need in a person’s life. People don’t need to be church members for us to help – we just need to step out there and make it happen.

**The future of the post-COVID church will not be the status quo, and that’s a good thing. Which is why it’s the perfect time to show the world what we can become.**

# A BETTER COVENANT WITH BETTER PROMISES

**The more the waves of darkness seem to push towards the shore of livelihoods, the more we are about to experience the prophetic declaration of the book of Isaiah 60:2 which says, "For in fact, darkness will cover the earth and deep darkness will cover the peoples; but the LORD will rise upon you [Jerusalem] and His glory and brilliance will be seen on you." (AMP)**

Just like the waves of darkness, the global impact of the pandemic has surely brought terror to so many lives. However, this should not keep believers from doing what the Lord commissioned us to do. A season such as this should motivate the Body of Christ to arise and become active ambassadors of the Kingdom of God. It is our responsibility as children of God to reflect the glory of God wherever we are and to serve in whatever capacity we may be called.

To align with this particular prophetic word of Isaiah, I believe we need to have a clear understanding of the covenant we have with the Lord. The Word of God declares that we have a better covenant with better promises (see Hebrews 8:6). Understanding the principles laid out in His Word will help better comprehend this thought. According to Baker's Evangelical Dictionary of Biblical Theology (Elwell 1996), the term "covenant" is of Latin origin (convenire), meaning a coming together. It presupposes two or more parties who come together to make a contract, agreeing on promises, stipulations, privileges, and responsibilities. It is always accompanied by vows, oaths, signs, and ceremonies performed to seal that particular covenant. However,

a covenant differs from a normal contract or an agreement that is temporal, because it is always binding 'til death.

A classic example to understand this concept is to look into the covenant between a husband and wife when entering into a union of marriage. Marriage requires lifelong faithfulness, commitment and dedication for it to flourish. Failure to honour vows inevitably destroys the integrity and benefits of such a union. This beautiful picture of the unfolding of our new covenant with the Lord is painted in the book of Ephesians 5:23-24 where the Word declares, "For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything." (NIV) This is a picture of the covenant that believers should have with Jesus Christ, a devotion that is sealed for eternity.

Our God is a covenant-keeping God and we see throughout scripture how He entered in a covenant with individuals, kings and nations. If you look back in the Old Testament and see how God dealt with Israel you will understand the

terms of your covenant because it was a shadow of the great things to come. God protected the children of Israel in Egypt against the death angel that was moving in the land. The blood of the sacrificial lamb became the shield that prevented the destroyer from harming them. This is exactly what Christ, the Lamb of God, has done for us; when He died on the cross, He covered us with His grace and mercy – and surely the effects of evil cannot have any power over us. Because of the blood of Jesus, we can stand firm in these days of adversity and overcome this present darkness.

The Lord continuously declares to us in His Word the terms of the new covenant which He has graciously given to us as a sign of His love and faithfulness. Ignorance of the Word has kept some believers from being active partakers of the new covenant and has held them back from accessing their rightful promises. Not having the proper knowledge is the main reason why some have not received the rewards and benefits of the new covenant. To break this paradigm, we need to know the will of our testator that instituted this new covenant. Through the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the New Testament was put into effect. (See Hebrews 9:16-26). The Word of God says, "And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance" (Hebrews 9:15, NKJV). To start, we need to acknowledge the finished work of the cross; that is, when Jesus Christ died and rose again in glory, He stripped bare Satan's authority and retrieved that which was lost. This covenant does not only nullify the works of the devil but also give us dominion over all the powers of darkness and the ability to triumph over them.

Jesus, the Lamb of God, sealed the covenant with His own blood – once

and for all. He placed authority upon the Church – the Body of Christ – to dominate and to perform miracles for the glory of God. Salvation is the channel that releases those rewards. It is unscriptural for a believer to live a life dominated by fear and restlessness when faced with challenges or trials. When we are established in the Word, we can be able to quench the attacks of the devil and overcome any obstacle this life can bring our way. When we know our place in God, we will never be overcome by the bad news surrounding us. We will be awake to the truth that our covenant holds better promises and its authority surpasses the systems of this world. As children of God we know that darkness is brought about by the influence from evil and that the only thing that can break that darkness is when we can know the Light and become light-bearers.

Under the new covenant, the blood is forever shielding us unto eternity; therefore we shouldn't be intimidated when darkness seems to cover our world. We have the benefits of protection, covering and providence. This covenant is better because it is not based on performances and animal sacrifices that do not profit anything but it is a gift of grace. And every time we come together to partake of Communion we place ourselves in a position to receive the benefits innate to it. By faith, we receive the benefits of divine healing, restoration, prosperity and protection. All these benefits are realised through obedience to God and His will for our lives. What God did in the lives of His children in times past He still pledges to us even today. God still uses the Word to reaffirm and communicate the terms of His covenant. Everything that we need to know about the new covenant is written in the commandments. The Word of God declares that when we can come to the full knowledge of this covenant then we will start manifesting His glory for all to see!
