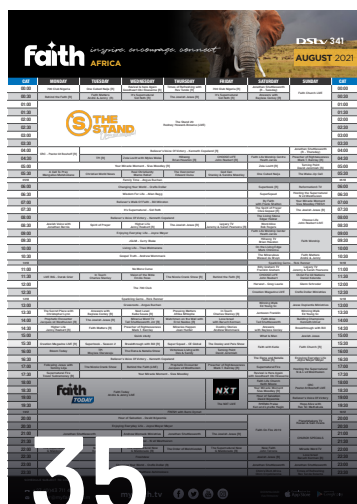

FROM THE EDITOR

CAN GOD'S WORD ACTUALLY ABIDE IN ME?

John 15:7, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you."

It's the last phrase of this verse that ALWAYS gives us hope isn't it? To know that whatever we ask of the Lord, He will do for us. What an awesome promise, from a faithful, wonderful, deeply caring God.

Now I have to say this right from the start - it's true this promise of us receiving whatever we ask is a direct result of us actively applying the first part of this verse: "...live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and (have) My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts..."

When Jesus tells us to abide in Him and have His words abide in us - it has nothing to do with us having to follow religious rules or regulations. We must remember knowledge without experience is dead religion - there's simply no power in it.

However, when we abide in Jesus - Who is the Living Word, and we have His Words abide in our hearts, it means we are spending time in His Word. We're listening to it, paying attention to its truth, and meditating on it. So God's Word actually abides in our hearts when we constantly think about how its timeless wisdom can be applied to our own lives, and we act on it.

This sounds easy enough, but is it really possible for us to do? Well, I believe that when we try to do this in our own strength, with our own understanding, we're probably going to end up dissatisfied. That's because understanding God's Word and then actually knowing how to apply it to our every day lives, can be rather tricky, especially when there are so many differing opinions and interpretations concerning what particular verses mean.

The truth is, Jesus knew full well what we'd be up against, and



that's why He sent us His Precious Holy Spirit. The Bible says the Holy Spirit will teach us God's ways, and reveal how the truth we're reading can actually affect our attitudes, the way we think, and speak, and act. He will give us clear understanding concerning God's Word so it can come alive on the inside of us and influence everything about us!

The Holy Spirit causes the Word to become more than just head knowledge! The first sign of it actually abiding in us is when it begins to deal with the motives of our hearts, before our actions. Making what we do sincere.

Here's how you can recognize the moment the word becomes more than just intellectual knowledge to you. It's when the truth you're reading, and thinking about moves from intellectual knowledge to

becoming your truth! In other words - what you really believe with all your heart.

It's when what the Word says is something you're absolutely convinced about. It's become your own opinion and makes perfect sense to you. You can actually see how it can become a practical part of your life. In fact, the Holy Spirit causes you to see exactly what your part is to walk in obedience to it! And this is the kind of obedience that carries you right into the blessing.

God's Word abides in our hearts when we don't just agree with it, we actually believe it and make it our own! We are convinced it's true for us and there is no question about practically aligning our lives with it. And the instant that 'penny drops', we actually feel a surge of joy and peace flood up from Holy Spirit in our own spirits!

The joy, pure hope, and freedom from fear that wells up inside us in this moment is very real! It's what the Bible calls revelation knowledge! What you may have seen and read in the Word before has suddenly become alive in you!

This is so powerful because it produces and keeps us secure in faith that God is completely in control of the very things we've poured out before Him, and we are completely convinced He really will do what His Word says concerning us!

This is what Paul meant when he said in Colossians 3:16 to, "Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns

and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts."

The Test

I was reading something Kenneth Copeland said he learnt from Oral Roberts. He said you can test, or recognize when the word is actually abiding in you and producing results - when you can hear it!

He explained it like this, when you get a song on your mind and you just keep hearing it over and over on the inside of you - that's how it happens when you're actually abiding in the Word.

You can be faced with a desperate situation, or even troubling thoughts over a desperate situation, when suddenly, as you cry out to the Lord, you hear a scripture come into your mind. It will be exactly what you needed to hear at that moment, and you'll know exactly what you need to do.

Even if it doesn't seem like your obeying it is going to make a difference in the bigger picture - you can believe your obedience to that Word is going to supernaturally set things in motion in the right direction for your miracle!

When you make a quality decision to spend time in the Word, with the Holy Spirit revealing its truth to you, and to obey exactly what He reveals to you to do - you'll see the word go to work for you and whatever you ask, shall be done for you - because it's actually abiding in you!

THE TRUTH ABOUT LIVING ON THE EDGE

Are you living an unsustainable life? Have you ever said things like, “I can’t keep this up much longer. If I have to live like this one more year, it’s probably going to finish me off. I tell you, it’s all just too much!”

Do you feel like you’re on a treadmill and if you try to get off, everything will fall apart, so you just keep going? This is what it means to “live on the edge.”

It seems these days that it’s a popular way to look at life. But it’s not the way God wants us to live. People who live on the edge are stressed-out by the demands of life, frustrated, hanging on, just trying to get through one more day. They have reached their limits but are ignoring them and hoping they can get by with it. If you’re living like this, you need to de-stress your life by establishing godly boundaries.

It’s very unfashionable in our American culture to say “I’ve had enough and can’t do anymore.” We seem to think we should be able to do it all, no matter how many commitments and obligations we have, and we compare ourselves with people who appear to be managing it all without a problem, which usually means we are getting our sense of worth and value from what we do, not who we are in Christ.

But I have good news for you: You don’t have to be like anybody else or keep up with anybody else. You need to be who you are — who God created you to be — and you don’t have to apologize for it. It’s okay to say, “I’ve reached my limit.”

Moses is a great example of this. In Exodus 18:13-27, we see that Moses was trying to do too much for the Israelites. He was a good leader, who took his responsibility seriously, but he needed help. When his father-in-law saw how much Moses was doing for the people, he said, “The thing that you are doing is not good” (verse 17 AMP). He then went on to say that if he continued this way, then Moses would wear out, and the people would get worn-out too. Moses could not do it all by himself. We can’t either.

Philippians 4:13 says we can do all things through Christ who gives us strength. Now this doesn’t mean God gives us strength to do everything we want or feel like we should do. God gives us His grace and strength to do what HE is calling us to do. And that’s all we should be doing. When we live like this, we will have peaceful and powerful lives.



So how do we do it? First we have to recognize that if something needs to change, we are going to have to take responsibility to change it. The world is not going to change, the devil is not going to change, and the people in your life may not want to change. But you can change.

The Word of God gives us guidelines and commandments that help us have a better life. For example, the Bible talks about wise thoughtfulness (see Proverbs 1:3). I have a tendency to be a rescuer, but loving people doesn't always mean helping them. Once I realized that Jesus didn't go around trying to make people let Him help them, it really set me free in this area. I was set free to be led by the Holy Spirit about who to help and how much I should help them.

Here's another example. The Bible says the borrower is a slave to the lender (see Proverbs 22:7). Don't be like the guy with the bumper sticker that says "I owe, I owe, so off to work I go."


Whatever you are struggling with – relationships, finances, sickness – the Bible has wisdom to help you set boundaries to change how you handle your situation. You'll find that godly boundaries make your relationships healthier, make you feel better, and help you keep your finances in order and under control.

With God's help, you can manage your life and not let it manage you. This is what it means to live within the boundaries of God's Word...and not on the edge.

CHILDLIKE FAITH

If we look at the Word of God, we see the love and the simplicity that Jesus has for little children.

Mark 10:13-16 (NKJV) says, "Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them."

As I'm growing older, God is giving me such patience and love for little children. It is such a pleasure for me to be able to spend time with my grandchildren. I am a very privileged man because God has blessed me and my wife, Jill, with eleven grandchildren and we also have many adopted children. My youngest grandchild is a mere nine months old and her name is Rebecca. One of the meanings of the word Rebecca is: "captivating."

She surely captivates me. In fact, she's got me right around her little finger. She is so beautiful, trusting and such a happy little soul. She is prepared to go to anyone who would like to hold her, and she brings a peace about her no matter what environment she's

in — so simplistic in her ways.

Jesus requires you and me to have childlike faith and not childish faith. What is childlike faith? It is: to believe and not continue questioning, to be trusting, to live for the moment, and not to be so competitive like the world seems to teach us. In fact, Jesus wants us to be completely opposite to the world's standards. The world teaches us to fight for everything we have; that to be the best we must trample on people all the way to the top; to not regard anyone else; but little children do not do that. They are giving, loving and trusting.

I can imagine the situation when Jesus had been preaching all day and was totally exhausted; then, the women brought little children to Jesus to ask Him to bless them. The disciples who loved the Lord could see that He was tired, so they tried to prevent the little ones to come to Him. But the Lord got quite irate and severely reprimanded His disciples. He said to them, I imagine quite sternly, "Let the little children come to Me and do not forbid them." The Bible says that Jesus then blessed them, and He said to the disciples "unless you are converted and become as little children,



you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:3)

Education is a wonderful thing and my children are all well-educated. I had the privilege of being able to afford to give them the best education I could, but education is not everything. One Prime Minister, Lloyd George, said "Education without Christ just makes clever little devils". That might sound a bit humorous, but it is true. Our children need Jesus and they need Him at all cost. It has been said "educators complicate, but communicators simplify". We need to keep the Gospel of Jesus Christ very simple because there is nothing difficult about it. Jesus even rebuked the Pharisees once about making it so hard for a man to enter into the Kingdom of Heaven (Matthew 23:13). All that God requires from us is childlike faith.

I have another grandchild who is seven years old, Nathan. He heard his Khulu (the Zulu word for grandfather, which is what they

call me) preaching a message on "quiet time". Spending time in the presence of God and putting the Lord first every day. He then wrote a message in his best handwriting on a piece of paper and gave it to me. It read, "Jesus is like a flame, you have to keep Him burning in your life." I was quite astounded when he gave me that piece of paper. In fact, I went and asked his father later when we were on our own if he had inspired Nathan to write that note, but he didn't know anything about it. That little boy realizes that if we don't spend time with the Lord, the fire of Christ in our hearts will go out. I haven't heard anything more profound!

Let us rather spend more time getting to know Jesus personally than trying to make Him academic. He is "a friend who sticks closer than a brother". (Proverbs 18:24).

God bless you as you develop your relationship with the Lord and as you study the characteristics of young children; that is how sincere our faith we ought to be if we are to enter God's Kingdom.

Thirty years ago, I was fired. I was married and had two young daughters who were two and five years old at the time. Fortunately, a year earlier we had sold our house and started renting in the expectation we would eventually move to Los Angeles.

But when you have a full time job, it's tough to pull the trigger on resigning to take a leap without a safety net, so I just kept putting it off.

Finally, I took some vacation time and bought a ticket to LA, so I could spend a week meeting people and interviewing for a position on the West Coast. But a few days before my flight I was called into the boss's office and handed my walking papers.

By 5 o'clock they wanted me out.

In spite of my expectation to leave on my own, getting fired is always a shock to the system. I left the office that afternoon, went home and told Kathleen, we sat on the bed and shed a few tears, but after a few minutes, we got up and re-focused everything

toward moving to Los Angeles.

It was hard, but looking back after 30 years, it was one of the best things that's ever happened to me. We finally stepped into our real calling, focused on what we knew we were supposed to be doing, and trusted God to help us chart a new path.

Over the years since, I've noticed a lot of other people who need to be fired.

Like I was, they've gotten stuck in a rut. Some have been bought off with a raise. Others know they're not doing what God has called them to, but they're afraid to step out into uncharted territory.

If that's you, this may be the sign you've been waiting for. I don't

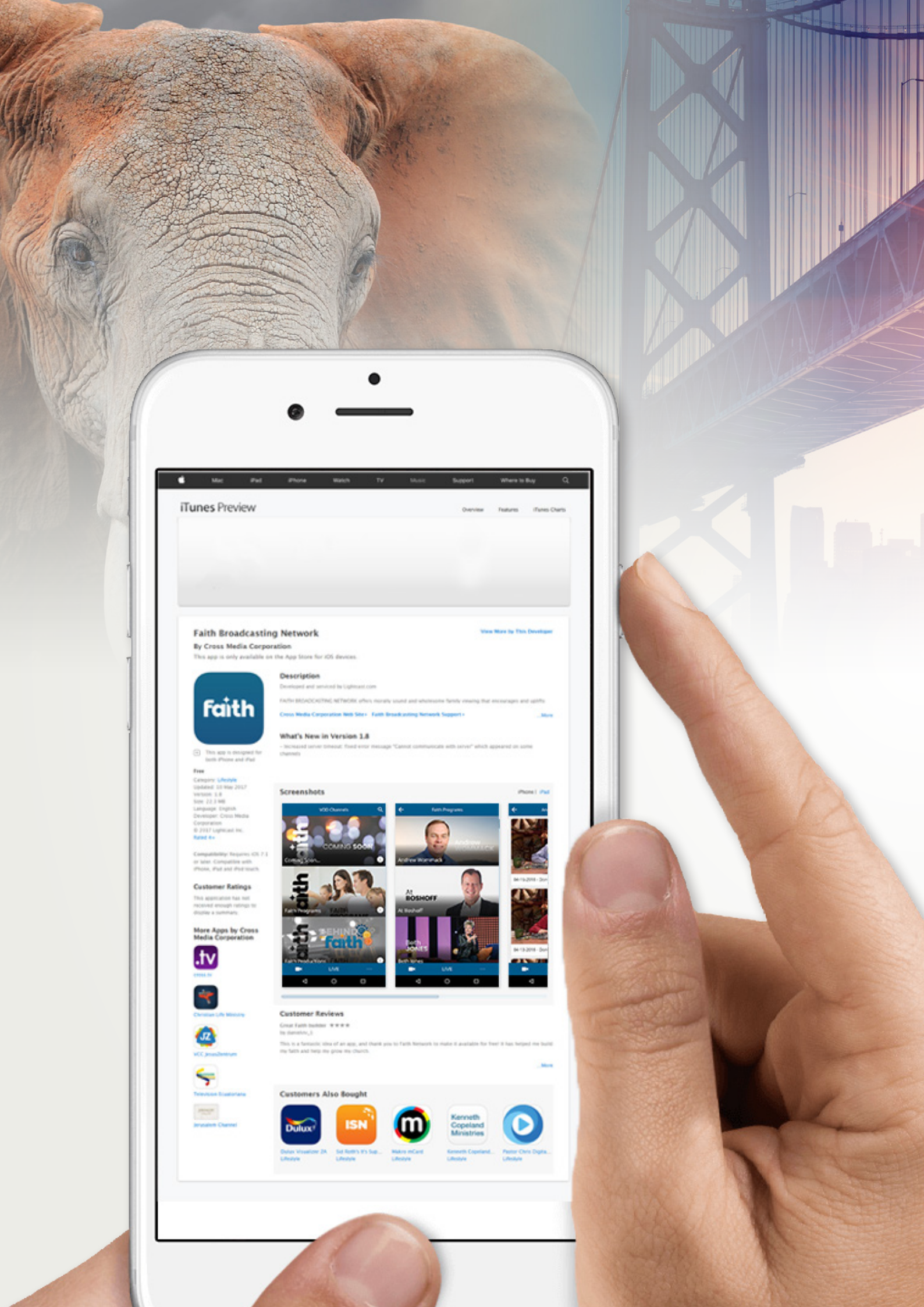


know your particular situation, so I can't make the decision for you. But I can assure you that if you feel your talent is being wasted, you hate going to work, or you're not fulfilling your destiny, this may be your moment.

Because I waited so long, I probably lost 5 or more years doing what I should have been doing, so don't let that happen to you. Every day you live outside your purpose is another day wasted.

Maybe it's time to fire yourself.

LEADERS: IT'S TIME TO BE TRANSPARENT

It's impossible to hide anymore... Recently, The Wall Street Journal reported on an interesting scandal in the Catholic Church.

Monsignor Jeffrey Burrill, a priest of the Diocese of La Crosse, Wis., was elected general secretary of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in November 2020. He's been described as the highest-ranking American Catholic cleric who is not a bishop.

But what's interesting is that this prominent priest was also leading a double life, and a new Catholic website called The Pillar held him to account. And what's even more interesting is how it happened. The Journal describes it this way:

The Pillar claims to have obtained a set of commercially available user data from Grindr, a location-based gay "hookup" app. By cross-referencing the Grindr data with other publicly available information, the Pillar was able to pinpoint a mobile device belonging to Msgr. Jeffrey Burrill. The device, the report claims, "emitted app data signals" from Grindr "on a near-daily basis during parts of 2018, 2019, and 2020."

Vox.com described Grindr in 2018 as an "underground digital bathhouse" whose purpose is to "help gay men solicit sex, often anonymously, online." At the very least most Catholics, liberal or conservative, would say this doesn't sound like the kind of thing a priest should have on his phone.

Whether the priest is guilty or not isn't the point of this post – the Church can deal with that. The key here is how they used technology to uncover his questionable activities.

I've said before that as Christian leaders in the 21st century, we can't hide. The river of information that flows through the Internet is so vast, that coupled with our mobile devices, we simply have to live transparent lives.

Obviously, we should be doing it anyway, but the continual revelation of Christian leaders experiencing moral failures shows

CALL ME FATHER

The word 'God' is never far from our lips. Unfortunately, it is sometimes heard in cursing but many times it is barely audible as someone utters His name in a moment of anguish. What do you think of when you think of 'God'?

I have become intrigued by this question and recently I conducted a survey. I was amazed how everyone gave a different answer! Here are a sample of the wonderful responses from believers: Gracious, Creator, Eternal, Joy, Big, Awesome, Safety, Love, Provision, Power, Majestic, My Rock, Comforter, Super Power, My Saviour, Good, Peace, Forgiving, Reliable and Friend. I am sure that you could add to the list! Like the many facets of a diamond, God displays Himself as the great 'I AM ...' (and you can fill in the blank!)

God has impressed on my heart the fact that he is ALL of the above and more but His hearts desire is that you relate to Him as your 'Father'. From the last verse of the Old Testament, Malachi 4:6, we see what is uppermost in the heart of God – the Father-son reconciliation, where the ungodly and rebellious sons will be reunited with a holy and perfect Father, through repentance! Thereafter God is silent for 400 years and then as the New Testament unfolds, God uses John the Baptist to speak to the people about the very same topic. (Luke 1:17) Jesus came to make God's dream of Fatherhood a reality. Jesus reveals God to us by becoming God-in-the-flesh. To see Jesus is to see God. When Jesus' disciples wanted to know who God was this is what Jesus

replied, 'He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?' (John 14:9b). Jesus reveals to us who God is but only the blood of Jesus can re-unite us to God in an intimate relationship. Satan would love believers to limit their thoughts of God to 'Creator' or 'Awesome' – words that hold God at arms length and beyond our reach. Satan trembles when we use the title 'Father'. The whole of the New Testament deals with the 'new' Father-child relationship between God-Man made possible through Jesus Christ.

Jesus always referred to God as 'Father'. The Father-child relationship so beautifully portrayed by God-Jesus can be ours today when we choose to repent and put our faith in Jesus as our only way back to God, the Father. What a tragedy if you keep God 'out there somewhere' when He wants to be closer to you than your own family.

Even born-again Christians are in danger of allowing other aspects of God to crowd out this fundamental relationship. Many sincere believers still feel that God is 'out there' and gesticulate with their hands as they refer to Him in

a vague manner. He is much more than your provider, your security, your peace . . . He is first and foremost your Heavenly Father! He is your Father, who provides; your Father, who loves you; your Father, who gives you peace. Jesus paid with His life to be your mediator: the only One who could put your hand in the Father's. Even the best earthly father cannot be compared to your Heavenly Father. I love the way Louis Giglio, an American preacher, describes it: God is not the reflection of your earthly father, He is the perfection of your father. He loves you perfectly and He gives His children perfect gifts. Draw close to God, talk to Him and next time someone asks you who God is you won't hesitate to say, "Oh, He's my Father!"

God longs to hear you call Him 'Abba, Father'. 'Abba' reminds me of the sounds that emanate from a small child who is learning to speak. I believe that Jesus slipped in this Aramaic word for Father to remind us of this father-child relationship. Jesus used the word, 'Abba' in the Garden of Gethsemane when He was in extreme anguish, yet submitting to God's will to suffer on your behalf. When the Spirit of Jesus Christ comes into our hearts a miracle occurs. Just as we cried out at our physical birth we cry "Abba, Father" at our spiritual birth when our spirits connect with the Spirit of the Living God. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" (Galatians 4:6).

It is the beautiful sound an adopted child makes when held in the arms of an Everlasting Father! . . . you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." (Romans 8:15b).

Enjoy every glorious facet of God but focus on the ultimate relationship - that of Heavenly Father - earthly child. He is your Father and He wants you to

be His child.

STATES OF RELATIONAL GRACE

A standard conversation with a twenty-something seems to inevitably always lead to that question.

If the person asking that question is of the slightly less tactful sort, the return question to a sometimes exasperated, sometimes desolate, sometimes hopeful "... no, not yet ..." often is ... "Shame! Why not?!"

Instead of then rebutting with an intentionally embarrassing fictional "... well, I have this problem ...", I have in the past elaborated on the Biblical purpose and practical advantages of being over 25 and unattached. These responses included seasonal adaptations of the well-quoted "singleness" scriptures, as well as valiant soliloquies on the freedom of independence and uncomplicated decision-making.

More often than not though these sermons, filled with brave statements about "being set apart for the Lord" and quotes from Lady in Waiting, failed to convince me or my sympathetic listener that I really am content with not currently being in a relationship that could potentially lead to matrimony.

There have been varying answers to the question: "Why am I still single?" Responses range from the harsh "... you / your future spouse must be disobedient by (insert sin here)" to the more hopeful "... it's just not time yet", with a range of well-meaning clichés in between.

More recently however, I have concluded that the issue is probably neither singleness nor marriage. In my of late acquired revelation these two "seasons of relational being" are nothing more, and nothing less, than two different "states of relational grace".

This is nothing new, but the penny actually dropped for me after years of struggling with 1 Corinthians 7. I actually have received a specific grace (gift or spiritual enablement from the Lord) to be single, as much as I would need a specific grace to be married.

We need grace to deal with singleness. We need grace to deal with marriage. A part of the victory over discontentment, in whichever season you are, lies in the promise of grace that is enough for each season.

Marriage and singleness have different challenges, but are equally effective in teaching us dependence on God. Being thankful, content and joyful are "soul-states" that are not dependant on anything else but a relationship with God. And that is where the scriptures comes alive... "God, not your marital status, defines your life".

We might actually not need another book on waiting for marriage ... I do however think we need practical Biblical handles on not getting



stuck in a mind-spaces that bring bondage, regardless of our marital status. I'm thinking that the process of being transformed into the image of Christ involves the intentional renewal of our minds and aggressive diligence in guarding our hearts, and singleness / marriage / sexuality are all equally effective training grounds for "fighting the good fight of faith".

The perceived benefits of marriage, according to multiple late-night-over-coffee debates with single friends from differing genders, are largely related to security, acceptance, intimacy, romance, companionship, shared purpose and destiny, and the plain and simple "it is not good for man to be alone". The experienced reality of many single people is that they feel excluded from these "relational benefits". On the other hand, my married friends have lamented the loss of independence and the stressful complications of shared decision making. Not to mention ill babies and lack of sleep ...

The challenges of both marriage and singleness seasons are unbearable without grace. "Never will I leave you nor forsake you" and "My grace is enough" are however eternal promises, unrelated to marital status.

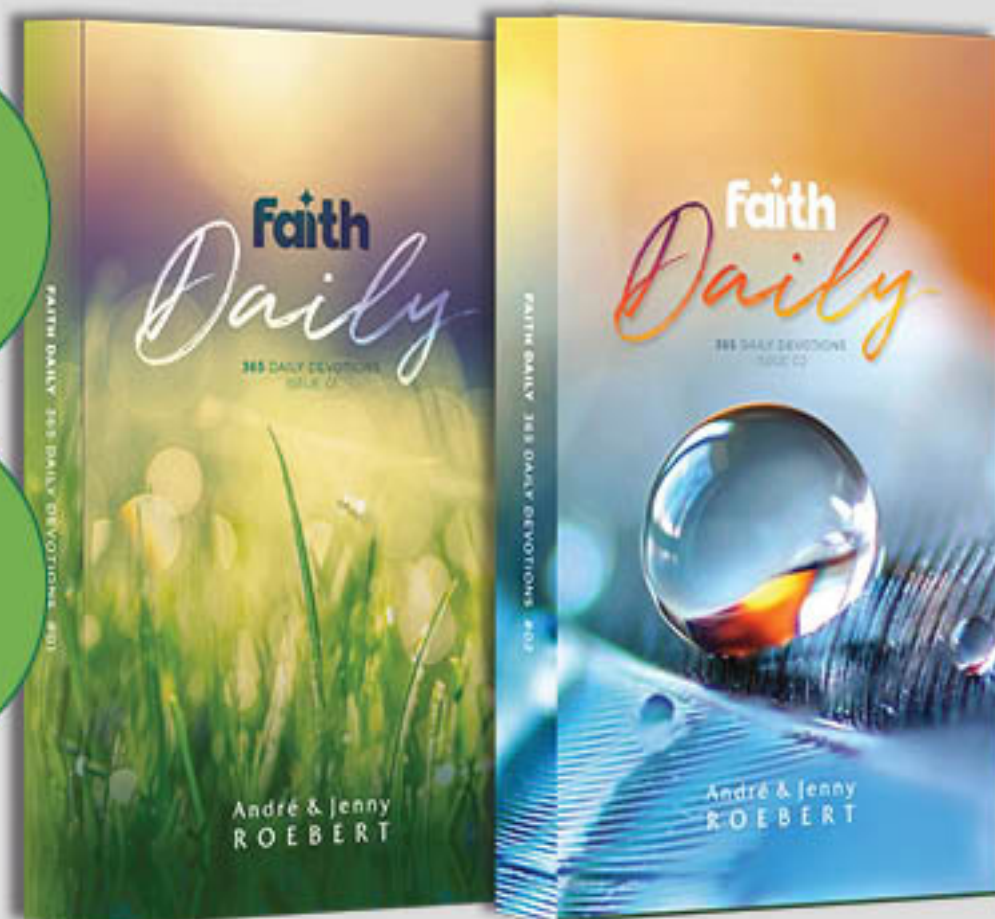
Fullness of life in every season is the inheritance of all believers. And I think that might be the point, and one of the lessons to be learned in different relational seasons. Grace is a gift. It cannot be demanded, only requested – and then lived in, to the max.
