We can speak to anyone about their experiences over the last year and the conversations will all be similar — the effects of the COVID pandemic on their lives. Over the last two years, since the first appearance of the dreaded virus our lives have changed dramatically, and it seems that 'constant change' is now the new normal. CAN WE SEE GOD?

John 14:21, "The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. [I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.]"

What a powerful scripture! Jesus promises to reveal Himself to us, to let Himself be clearly seen by us, and make Himself real to us. Isn't this the cry of all our hearts? Well, according to this verse - it's a promise we can certainly experience. And not just when our bodies die and our spirits go to heaven, but now, while we are here, living on earth!

Obviously the question we need answered is how? How, on earth, do we get to see Jesus this way? Well, the first part of this piece of scripture tells us quite clearly doesn't it? It all has to do with God's Word abiding so strongly in us, that we begin to know and experience His overwhelming love for and in us. This is where we get to see Jesus.

Let's back up a little to John 15:7, where Jesus speaks about His Word abiding, or living in our hearts.

John 15:7 says, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you."

I believe this verse holds the key for us to see Jesus and walk in the fullness of life and victory Jesus secured for us, through the finished work of the cross. It sheds critical light on how our relationship with God's Word directly affects our relationship with Him and the influence this relationship has on our prayers - when we pray from this place of abiding!

Previously I began explaining the transformation process we experience when we choose to abide in Jesus - the Living Word; and have His Words continually live inside us.



Today, I want to go a little deeper in explaining this process, showing you how the Word of God, when embraced, becomes a surgical tool in the hands of the Holy Spirit - to the place where the eyes of our hearts are wide open to see God.

Hebrews 4:12 says, "For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart."

Oh, I can't tell you how much I love this verse, it holds such weighty truth! You can't but shudder at the authority it credits to the word

"The power of God's Word allows us to clearly see the glory of God!" of God being alive in our hearts. That's why it's essential for us to hold God's word in such high regard. It is alive and full of power to go to work on the inside of every believer and transform our very nature, at its core.

It's that same seed of God's incorruptible word that was supernaturally planted within our spirits the moment we accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour of our lives. It began its transforming work the instant we received and embraced it! That work was so powerful it snatched us out of the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of light in an instant!

Can you just imagine what it can do in and to us if we continue to let it dwell in us richly? Oh my, I can, because scripture tells us exactly what it can and will do, if we fully open our lives to it:

2 Corinthians 3:18 says, "And all of us, as with unveiled face, [because we] continued to behold [in the Word of God] as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendour and from one degree of glory to another; [for this comes] from the Lord [Who is] the Spirit."

There it is - the power of God's Word allows us to clearly see the glory of God. We see the very nature of God: His goodness, His kindness, His faithfulness, His mercy, His awesome power, His majesty, His indescribable beauty. The true nature of God is revealed as a reflection when we look deeply, with open, eager hearts into His Word.

Now, because His Holy Spirit is doing the revealing, what we learn

and see goes beyond mere knowledge. We don't just learn about the nature of God when His Word comes alive in us - we experience Him! We actually encounter Him in His word.

And it's when we do, we are changed, one glorious degree at a time into His very own image. And it's not just a small degree of change - it's a continuous, ever increasing degree of splendour, from glory to glory! All done by His Spirit Who lives inside us!

You'll recognise the process of this transformation the instant the word becomes life to you. It's as though the light was switched on in your soul, and you see and understand something with more than just in your mind, your spirit actually leaps with joy at the truth that has reached its home in you.

You actually feel so connected to the Lord and alive in Him at that very moment. You actually feel Him in that truth because you experience everything the Word says His Presence is.

The spontaneous joy, the pleasure and delight, the peace, the unfailing hope, His overwhelming love - all of it abounding at the same time, rushing up like a powerful fountain inside you. This is where the Holy Spirit reveals God to us, in His Word.

For me, this is where I know, without a shadow of a doubt, He is alive in me, He is with me, He is for me, and He is EVERYTHING His word says He is to me! It's when I know I'm completely rooted in Him, and every worry, every concern, every fear pales in comparison to the confidence and faith I have in Jesus and His incorruptible Word that's alive and dwelling in me - all in that moment.

So what does this have to do with what we can believe God for in prayer? Well, everything! You see, experiencing Jesus in His word like this, where your confidence and faith is so real and great - that's when you begin to pray from inside the throne room of God! That's when you begin to declare His word with true power and authority from a position of being seated in heavenly places with Him!

That's when every word you pray resonates with the Spirit of God - as though He is praying through you. You can literally sense each word going out with such power that the very atmosphere around you is charged and there is no doubt that it's producing exactly what it's declaring in the spirit realm as well as the natural - Hallelujah!

Why? Because we are praying in and on the authority of the Living, revealed Word of God! Against this - nothing can withstand!

When Jesus said, "If you live in Me [abide vitally united to Me] and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you."; He gave us a key that will unlock the reality of living in the fullness of life and victory He paid the price for us to enjoy.

IMAGINE YOUR LIFE FREE FROM FEAR

Do you ever wonder what your life would look like if fear didn't exist? For example, what if you had the confidence to pursue every passion God gave you?

Just imagine for a moment what that would look like. Well, God gives us a special gift called faith so we can do amazing things for Him. And I want to encourage you to step out of your comfort zone and exercise that gift full time.

Faith gives us so much potential because it motivates us to move forward in the plans God has for us. But fear is a feeling Satan uses to keep our focus inward. It makes us feel anxious, causes us to dread the future, and it can keep us from saying and doing things that would reveal more of God's love to the world.

We need to learn to interrupt fear at its onset—before it begins to settle in our spirit. The choice is to either let Satan stop us in our tracks or to go forward in faith, believing God is in control.

The good news is, when we're struggling with fear, we can turn to God's Word for an inspiring, encouraging reality check. Romans 8:31 (NIV) says, "If God is for us, who can be against us?" And Psalm 27:1 says, "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall

I be afraid?"

These scriptures are basically saying that if we believe God's Word, then we have already won the battle we're facing. Jesus tells us in Mark 11:22 (AMPC), "Have faith in God [constantly]." God doesn't want you to be fearful at any time. He wants you to be bold, confident, courageous and full of faith every day of your life—not just until you have a problem or until someone mistreats you. There's no until. And no one can stop God from answering a prayer that lines up with His Word and His will for our life.

Keeping the Faith While You're Waiting

Throughout the course of a lifetime, we spend a lot of time waiting. And that is often the case with prayer. We can spend years praying for something to happen. And during that time, Satan will do everything he can to discourage us. He will try to convince us that God doesn't love us, that God's promises are for more worthy people, or that we didn't really hear from God in the first place. But if we will choose to trust God continually, we can keep moving



forward in His plans for us.

The truth is, even if you don't see the fulfillment of every dream or desire of your heart here on earth, God will be pleased as you continue to believe in His perfect plan. And in the meantime, your faith will fill you with hope, joy and peace (see Romans 15:13).

Now if you knew me years ago, you would know that I wasn't always filled with hope. In fact, I was miserable whenever God made me wait for anything, so I would try to make things happen on my own. And it eventually wore me out! I remember lying on the floor, crying, saying, "God, I've tried everything and nothing's working. I just give up!" At that moment, the Holy Spirit spoke to my heart and said: Really, Joyce? You mean, you're going to let Me take it from here?

You see, when we're ready to let go, God is right there to fight our battles. We just need to learn to trust Him...and that comes through experience, as we take each new step of faith.

Overcoming Opposition with Consistency

Today, instead of trying to pray my problems away, I've learned to pray for things like strength and courage, and for the power to endure whatever comes with a good temper. With God's help, I can choose faith every time I'm confronted with feelings of fear or intimidation.


Philippians 1:28 says not to be "frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved—and that by God."

OVERCOMING THE CULTURE'S AVERSION TO OUR CHRISTIAN WITNESS

I spent a few hours recently reading social media posts from people who aren't just disinterested in Christianity; they are openly hostile.

All things "church," "Christian," "Bible," and similar topics are regularly criticized, ridiculed, and satirized on their platforms.

At first, I felt a sadness that this many people would spend so much time bashing something they dislike instead of taking a more positive approach to what they do like. But that's a personal choice and I can't change their decision about what they choose to do online.

However, on closer inspection, I noticed just how focused and intentional they were about ridiculing the certainty Christians have about the gospel. After all, we firmly believe what the Bible says, and we've read the last chapter and know what's coming. There's also a large group of believers who can testify to a miraculous work of God in their lives.

All that's great, but at a particular point, "certainty" can bleed into "arrogance," and to a non-believer, that's naturally repulsive.

We see a similar arrogance from people who allow their politics to

blind them to reality.

Our allegiance to sports teams, our alma mater, or professional groups derail us from the truth. In our passionate pursuit of a career, we can easily step on people in our way.

Those are just a few examples, but we're all put off when it happens. So even with well-intentioned efforts to share our faith, when the culture hears such a level of certainty about the gospel that it tilts toward arrogance, they naturally want nothing to do with it

Maybe it's time we back off the certainty and start sharing the questions, doubts, and complexity of our faith. I do believe God has all the answers, but I certainly don't — so maybe I should be more open to engaging people on that basis.




From a secular perspective, when it comes to persuading the public, Alison Monk, founder and CEO of the advertising and marketing agency Eden Collective says, "People are afraid to tell the story of complexity. They're afraid to tell the story that sometimes you just don't know all the answers."

I think she's on to something. We can have confidence in our faith and still not have all the answers, so what if we were more open about it? Even when outsiders disagree with us, it's hard to criticize, ridicule, and make fun of people who are honest about what they believe.

Jesus certainly knew all the answers, but it's interesting that He spent most of his time asking questions.

LEADERS: HOW TO SPOT GREAT TALENT

The best people can change everything... To be a great leader in the 21st century, you'll need the ability to find and recruit talented members of your team.

Darticularly when it comes to creative teams, spotting gifted and talented people is absolutely critical, and yet I'm amazed at the poor hires organizations often make. To help you avoid the pain, here's a few quick tips to help:

- 1) Check references. This sounds so basic, but you'd be amazed at how many employees are hired simply on their own word. Then once they start working, it becomes painfully clear they're not nearly as talented or experienced as they led everyone to believe. Get multiple perspectives and actually talk to their references. Obviously, references can be biased, but I suggest asking the references for other suggestions of people who have experience with the candidate. Go deeper.
- **2) Think chemistry.** I'd rather have a moderately talented team that loves working together than a group of geniuses that can't play well with others.

- **3) Avoid catching the "expert from afar" virus.** We often think someone from the outside will be amazing, while overlooking emerging talent inside your organization. Remember that it takes time and money to bring outsiders up to speed, understand your DNA, and learn the culture, while insiders already know it.
- **4) Be a coach.** Athletic coaches train, create the right environment, and inspire then send their athletes onto the field. Stop micromanaging and allow your team to fly. You'll spot the most talented members pretty quickly.
- **5) Diversity does matter.** You may be tired of hearing the media's constant droning mantra of "diversity" today, but when considered correctly it can make a dramatic difference. Is your leadership team all white, middle aged males? All minority women? All young people? You'll never achieve your greatest



potential without a wide variety of perspectives. It's not just about race, gender, or politics — it's all of the above and more.

6) Finally, if he or she sounds too good to be true, they probably are. Don't be cynical, just ask a lot of questions. I met a media director at one church who claimed he had worked for "Fox Television," and led everyone to believe it was Fox TV national. But it turned out it was a local Fox owned TV station somewhere in lowa. Hillsong has never even hired the number of people who claim to have worked for that church. Another candidate said he had produced Super Bowl TV commercials, but we found out it was a low-budget hot tub spot that aired locally adjacent to the broadcast in Spokane.

You'll elevate your leadership the moment you make finding and developing talented team members a priority. Stop doing so much heavy lifting yourself, and take the time to spot the kind of talent that can help your team achieve greatness!

This healing work, this rebuilding, is fueled and sustained by a posture of humble prayer.

If 2020 taught us anything, it is that we are not in control. Our plans are dust. We cannot make anything of lasting kingdom value happen (or not happen) by willpower alone. As Jesus said, we can do nothing apart from him. (John 15:5)

With so many of us newly aware of our inability to see the way forward, we have an opportunity to rally together and pray. One thing is clear,:the world is transitioning and many people are questioning their values, changing/losing jobs, relocating and questioning life altogether.

What if we were to meet this global season of transition with a great uprising of fervent prayer and fasting?

What if thousands of intercessors began to fast for extended 20-, 30-, or 40-day fasts for vitality of the Church and for a renewed focus on the kingdom of God in all its goodness and kindness and gentleness? The seriousness of the global moment requires a deep commitment to seeking God's kingdom above all things

Let us stop working in our own strength. Let us fall to our knees and ask God to work, God to change hearts, God to bring healing through us to the walking bruised and weary of our world.

But the opportunity of 2021 doesn't stop with "prayer and hope," it merely starts there.

We must be the hands and feet of Jesus in action.

The prayer of St. Francis can be a guide for us here:


"Lord make Me an instrument of Your peace. Where there is hatred let me sow love. Where there is injury, pardon. Where there is doubt, faith. Where there is despair, hope. Where there is darkness, light. Where there is sadness, joy."

But how do we do this? How do we become instruments of peace?

Perhaps we can find a hint in the 2020 Barna Group study, which suggests that 62% of non-Christians and lapsed Christians say that the top quality they would look for when it comes to talking with someone about faith is someone who listens without judgment. The second thing they look for is someone who doesn't force or pressure them to draw a conclusion.

Listening. Without judgment. Leaving space for the Spirit to work. Without pressure.

These are the things Alpha is all about. We desire to create a safe space where anyone from any background can ask questions without fear of judgment; where they can explore faith without being forced to form fast opinions, where they can connect with others and experience God's Spirit for themselves.



Isn't that exactly what the world is hungry for right now? People are longing to be seen and heard. As author and pastor, Mark Sayers writes in his book, Reappearing Church, "Crisis precedes renewal."

What if our renewal included a return to prayer with renewed vigor, along with a commitment to love the stranger; to meet people where they are and offer them what they long for—an ear to hear, a shoulder to cry on, a friend to walk beside them?

When we started providing Alpha Online we thought we were meeting a need specific to the pandemic—and we were. But we learned that there are many on the margins who wouldn't be comfortable at an in-person Alpha, or who wouldn't be able to come at all.

- The single working mom, who has no options for childcare.
- The cancer patient whose immune system is compromised and can't be in large groups.
- The grandma with MS who struggles to get around.
- The middle-aged man with crippling anxiety and OCD who fears leaving his house.
- The teenager who doesn't have a car and spends most of his time at home, alone, online.

Alpha Online has paved a way for these people to interact with others and learn how much Jesus loves them. It's opening doors we didn't even realize were shut and locked. Now as the opportunity to meet in person is available, let's take that pandemic spirit of resourcefulness back into our familiar spaces. As we return to semi-familiar rhythms, let's posture ourselves to listen and love everyone in our community. Who else can we reach who we haven't reached before? How can we connect with others who wouldn't typically have an opportunity to hear about or experience the love of Jesus? These questions hold exciting opportunities for those who are willing to creatively adapt.

We witnessed this sort of creative adaptation when churches came together during the pandemic to support each other during a challenging year. Those with technical skills helped their neighbors without. Communities combined

services and pooled resources when needed. Our country may have become more polarized, but the need for supporting and listening to one another could not be more urgent. There's an opportunity here for us to continue to hold each other up, to build foundations of mutual respect between different expressions of the body of Christ. Moving forward, how can we continue to look out for each other? How can we work together to support and serve one another in love, as fellow members of God's family? How can we share and collaborate? Our world is full of division, competition, and exclusion. But not so with the kingdom of God! Here and now, we have an opportunity to show the world something different, something holy.

"By this everyone will know that you are my disciples if you love one another." (John 13:35)

In the last year and a half, the entire world has experienced a common global crisis together. Rarely in human history has every region of the world experienced the same trauma together. In the midst of that, we've witnessed hopeless indifference, exhausted moral failures, and aggressive attacks on our ability to love each other. However, we have also witnessed love and collaboration in the midst of a crisis. Now, we have an opportunity to continue that work and extend love in the midst of our new ordinary.

This is how the Church can emerge from the pandemic well—

- stronger by listening; stronger by love;
- our love for one another.
- our love for other expressions of the body of Christ.
- our love for the stranger outside our walls, those who don't know or claim Jesus' name.
- our love for the marginalized, the hurting, the wounded, the lost.

We love because God first loved us.

This is the nature of the kingdom of God.

THE MINISTRY OF HOSPITALITY

On my travels throughout South Africa and my interaction with people I have become increasingly aware of the impact simple deeds have on people. One of these is hospitality. I have come to the conclusion that hospitality is not really an option but rather a reflection of a lifestyle in the Kingdom of God.

ospitality is a biblical doctrine that is found intertwined in Scripture, and is an extension of the way we allow other people to experience our homes. It creates a time for us to speak and live out the gospel of Jesus Christ in a profound way as it has the power to touch hearts and change lives in the most profound way.

There is a real art in making people feel welcome in our homes; strangers, and even people we invite don't automatically feel welcome in our homes and we have to put some effort in to make them feel welcome.

The apostle Peter instructs us to "cheerfully share our home with those in need, a meal, or place to stay for the night" (1 Peter 4: 9 TLB). Central to having a welcoming home is to share our table, and in the book of Acts this is often mentioned. I believe that it is God's heart that we extend our table to others.

In the current times, where safety precautions are kept to protect our homes and family as well as a tight budgets, it is even more of a challenge to treat our enemies as guest (which is what the Word of God says). Hospitality doesn't just mean to treat the ones that we have invited with honour and grace, but even occasional strangers.

I have been fortunate in my travels to stay over at friends while doing the work of Dynamis. It has been a conscious choice on my part not to stay on my own, but to be in homes where I can share in the households, and also share life together. This has become an enormous inspiration to me over the years since it really is an opportunity to influence lives and be influenced by others. If I, as a friend of these households feel so honoured, I can just imagine how much more a stranger would be blessed by a similar experience.

There are many examples in the Word of God showing the hospitality of God as He invited people to come to Him.

- "Everyone come to the waters, and you who have no money, come, buy and eat" (Isaiah 55:1).
- "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give your rest" (Matthew 11: 28)
- "Come, and let him who thirst come, and whoever is thirsty, let him come, and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life" (Revelation 22: 17).

From examples such as these it becomes clear that hospitality should be a lifestyle. This is a time when we can serve others. Hospitality encapsulates in essence who we are when people enter our homes,



and give us an opportunity to be the hands of God to them. Hospitality is distinctly different to entertainment, where the emphasis on the latter is on how good I am to impress people. In Hebrews it is clear that part of salvation and the believer's daily routine was the sharing of meals together.

One might think that people in urban areas, who are living in closer proximity, will automatically gather together, but it seems as if city-dwellers are lonelier than ever. It also seems that people have a false sense of connectedness and friendship - cyber friends are often an illusion of a community of friends. One might need to be more intentional in inviting people over to our homes to truly connect - this is the setting and place where people get to know one another, and where the heart and gift of others can be seen.

Peter's suggestion that we should keep on "practising hospitality" seems to be born out of the example of Jesus; Jesus practises hospitality by feeding hungry crowds! When people enter our homes over mealtimes, we should offer them food to eat without grumbling (1 Peter 4: 7 -9). It seems to me the way that we are prepared to share with others is a reflection of our hearts.

We do not have to leave our homes to touch lives. We can just invite

people to our homes. Nancy Campbell in her book Family Meal Times says, "your home can be an evangelistic centre, a counselling centre, a consulting clinic and healing centre." All people can reach out to others. Single people, widows and families can reach out to the lonely, singles, single parent families, the elderly, strangers and non-Christians.

I have, through my life, got wise council from mentors and friends about problematic areas in my life. The meal table provided that atmosphere to share hearts, get correction, cry together or come to a place of comfort. The transparency of these shared lives makes it possible to experience this type of hospitality and unity. My daughter did not always appreciate it when I discussed heart-to-heart matters with close friends at the meal table, but I know that she has learnt from this example to call out to other believers if a burden becomes too heavy.

Hebrews 10: 24-35 makes it clear that in the last days we will need to increasingly practice hospitality. It certainly is my aim to be more hospitable, so that I can be pleasing to God, how about you? Whoever wants to become great among others must first be a servant (Matthew 20: 26 -28).




In LIVING FULL André Roebert explores the triangular relationship between our financial prosperity, our health and issues pertaining to the prosperity of our soul.




