By now most of us are in full swing of 2022, and if you are like me, astounded that time seems to have no go-slow! We come armed with resolutions, ideas, dreams and goals and attack January with gusto, only to often marvel at the progress in comparison to the time elapsed by the mid-year mark.

We do have a great consolation though, and that is that God is aware of this and has given us a special "gift" to manage that! Solomon writes, "A person may have many ideas concerning God's plan for his life, but only the designs of God's purpose will succeed in the end" (Proverbs 19:21). When I read this I am reminded that God has amazing plans for my life, and with that also the perfect timing to see those plans materialize! "kingdom" part all waxed but fail miserably in the "righteousness" department. You see, the instruction by Jesus has two parts: the kingdom of God, and the righteousness of God. If I understand it correctly the kingdom refers to the way God does things, while the righteousness of God refers directly to His character and nature.

We are called, as His creation, to be just like Him in all things, which means that we must adapt our behavior to mirror that of His! The way we treat people, the way we speak to people, the way that we act towards other people, in short, our entire sphere of inter-personal relationships should be equal to that of God to us. The love, grace and mercy He extends to us, should also be extended by us to others.

There are some people in the Church who claim to do things for the sake of the kingdom (and much of it may be true and well), but in the process they either use or discard people ostensibly for the sake of the Kingdom. If this is the case, I propose that they are not really seeking the kingdom of God at all. I believe that the kingdom and God's righteousness are not mutually exclusive, but work in a symbiotic fashion.

Let us take heed to the "how" of applying kingdom principles in our lives and let us not forget that we are not isolated on our own religious island, but that we are a community of believers worshipping the One God.

Let us extend love and see the kingdom prosper, and then all our plans will be taken care of automatically.



# EVIDENCE OF HIS POWER IN YOU

The baptism of the Holy Spirit is a precious gift for every born-again believer and is essential for us to live out our Christian faith purposefully and victoriously.



**A**s we study the scriptures, we see how speaking in tongues, which is a personal, heavenly, prayer language is available for every Believer who is baptised in the Holy Spirit. There are such amazing benefits for those who regularly spend time praying in their heavenly language, in fact they are so wonderful that we simply cannot ignore the importance of this precious gift.

Regardless of the denomination to which you belong or what you have been taught to believe, it is an irrefutable fact that Jesus said believers would speak with new tongues. Jesus said in Mark 16:17, *"And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues"*.

One of the benefits of praying in tongues is that it provides evidence that we are filled with the supernatural power of God!

As a born-again child of God, your body has become the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit! 1 Corinthians 6:19, *"Do you not know that your body is the temple (the very sanctuary) of the Holy Spirit Who lives within you, Whom you have received [as a Gift] from God? You are not your own"*.

1 Corinthians 6:17, *"But the person who is united to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him."* This means your spirit and His Holy Spirit have become one! At the point of your conversion, the Holy Spirit took your human spirit which was lost to sin, and recreated it in Himself! *"Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!"* (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Every child of God can receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit. This is where we ask the Holy Spirit to fill us up and activate us with His power. It's important to note that when we become born again, the Holy Spirit does take up residency in us, and promises to remain in us. He doesn't leave us. However, to activate His power to flow in and through us - to do what is naturally not possible to do, we need the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Look at what John the Baptist said about Jesus, *"John gave further evidence, saying, I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and it dwelt on Him [never to depart]. And I did not know Him nor recognize Him, but He Who sent me to baptizein (with) water said to me, Upon Him Whom you shall see the Spirit descend and remain, that One is He Who baptizes with the Holy Spirit. And I have seen [that happen—I actually did see it] and my testimony is that this is the Son of God!"* (John 1:32-34).

The Holy Spirit empowered Jesus to operate supernaturally from that moment on. His power flowed through Jesus as He worked signs, wonders and miracles. It also gave Him the power to withstand the temptation and attack of the enemy.

Jesus was then led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil (Luke 4:1). Because the Holy Spirit gave Him the appropriate word to respond every time, He stood up to the devil and overcame every temptation and trap he had laid out for Him. This is important for us to pay attention to, because when we are baptised in the Holy Spirit, we are given the same power to overcome every trap and temptation the enemy has laid up for us.

Look at what happened next: Luke 4:14, 17-19, *"Then Jesus went back full of and under the power of the [Holy] Spirit into Galilee, and the fame of Him spread through the whole region round about....And there was handed to Him [the roll of] the book of the prophet Isaiah. He opened (unrolled) the book and found the place where it was written, The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound]."*

Just as the Holy Spirit empowered Jesus to do all this, the baptism of the Holy Spirit we receive empowers us to do the very same!

A wonderful way to understand this is by looking at what the Word baptism means. It comes from the Greek Word *baptizo* meaning to fully submerge. It gives a picture of a piece of cloth being fully submerged into a container that is filled with a solution of water and dye. Once that cloth is completely soaked in that solution, it has been baptised in it. When that cloth is lifted out of that solution, it has taken of the exact colour, and even smell of what saturated it.

When we are baptised with the Holy Spirit, our spirits are literally saturated and soaked in His power. We are full of and activated by power to do the very same supernatural works Jesus did. In John 14:12 Jesus said, *"I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, if anyone steadfastly believes in Me, he will himself be able to do the things that I do; and he will do even greater things"*



*than these, because I go to the Father.” Jesus knew that only once He left the earth to go to His Father, the Holy Spirit would be able to inhabit the lives of those who believed in and accepted Jesus as their Saviour.*

Once we are baptised in the Holy Spirit, being filled with His power is something that is not just done once and never again. In fact the Bible tells us to continue being filled with His power. Ephesians 5:18 says, *“And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but ever be filled and stimulated with the [Holy] Spirit.”* Every time we need a fresh empowerment of the Holy Spirit’s power to spiritually strengthen and energise us, we can use our faith and ask the Holy Spirit to fill us full of a fresh empowering of His supernatural power. In fact it’s something that is expected of us, not just suggested.

Speaking in tongues is evidence that we have been baptised and filled with the power of God. It’s proof that our bodies are wholly filled and flooded with that power.

Ephesians 1:19 says that we can know and understand the, *“...immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength....”*

Ephesians 3:19 speaks of how we are, *“...filled [through all our being] unto all the fullness of God [may have the richest measure of the divine Presence, and become a body wholly filled and flooded with God Himself].”*

Every time we pray in tongues we are reminded of and have evidence of how our frail human bodies hold within them a treasure that is so powerful and glorious, it cannot be kept for just ourselves! The power of God that is in us empowers us to do His will and carry out His purpose supernaturally while we are on earth.

*“However, we possess this precious treasure [the divine Light of the Gospel] in [frail, human] vessels of earth, that the grandeur and exceeding greatness of the power may be shown to be from God and not from ourselves.” (2 Corinthians 4:7)*

What a glorious gift we have to constantly remind us of the power that resides inside us. This heavenly language is pure evidence of that resident power.

# GET FREE FROM THE BURDEN OF STRESS

It seems that stress is the disease of the century. Products and programs to manage stress are a multi billion-dollar business, whether the “cure” is medicine, counseling, books, seminars or classes. But I’ve discovered that God’s way of managing stress is the most effective way to live.

Jesus says in John 14:27 (AMP): “Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]”

I know what it’s like to live under the burden and pressure of stress, and I know what it’s like to have God’s peace. I can honestly say that I will do whatever I have to do to have God’s peace in my life, because it is not God’s will for us to live with stress all the time.

It’s easy for us to feel like we can’t avoid being stressed-out because it’s just the way the world is today. But the truth is just because stress is a disease of our culture, it doesn’t mean we have to adopt the ways of our culture and live the same way.

We have two options: We can continue to be stressed-out until we fall apart, or we can learn how to receive the peace Christ gives in every circumstance, rather than letting stress get into us.

## The Cure for Stress

For many years, I lived with constant stress. I was sexually abused by my father throughout my childhood. Then when I left home at the age of 18, I married the first man who came along because I was afraid no one else would want me, and that led to five years of misery. He ended up abandoning me.

By the time I was 23 and met Dave Meyer, I was a mess! I was worried, full of fear, insecure and had a poor self-image. So I tried to find value in what I did and became a workaholic.

Over time, I developed physical problems, like frequent headaches and backaches, and had problems in many of my relationships because I was unhappy and hard to get along with. I finally came to the place where I decided that I would not live that way any longer. Whatever it took, I was going to have God’s peace and live a peaceful life!

James 1:21 says, “...With a humble spirit receive the word [of God] which is implanted [actually rooted in your heart], which is able to save your souls.” Although I was a Christian during this time of my life, I needed to “get saved” in my soul—my mind, will and emotions. I needed

to renew my mind with the Word of God so I could know the Truth and be set free from the root issues of my stress.

Here’s how it works: When we study God’s Word—reading it, meditating on it, getting it deep down in our hearts—it changes the way we think. This causes us to change the way we talk, which changes our attitudes, and then our behavior changes. At this point, the things around us—our circumstances—can’t control us anymore.

## Get to the Root of Your Stress


Being set free from the pressure of stress begins with God’s Word, but we also have to understand that if things are going to change in our lives, we will have to take responsibility to change them with God’s help. So the first thing we need to do is pray and be willing to hear what He has to say about the real root of our problem.

If you’re already doing your part, then be determined to trust God to fix things. But if you’re not walking in wisdom or you’re doing things a certain way just because that’s the way everybody else is doing it, then follow the direction He is speaking to your heart to make a change.

We must pray and obey! This means we make a commitment not to live based on the culture around us but by the leading of the Holy Spirit, who lives in us as born-again believers in Christ. Our mind-set should be: With God’s help, I’m ready to make a change. Then as we do what He shows us to do (or what He shows us not to do), we’ll be able to live in peace.

Pursue the peace Jesus is offering you today. It’s not the kind the world gives—the kind you have as long as your circumstances are the way you want them to be. The peace Jesus gives makes you calm and undisturbed on the inside, in your soul, no matter what’s going on around you.

Study other scriptures about peace, like Philippians 4:6-7, Colossians 3:15 and 1 Peter 3:11. Put your trust in God completely and enjoy the life Jesus died to give you. Through Christ, you can learn how to manage the stress of this world, instead of letting stress manage you!

# UNCAPPED FAITH

WHEN THE LORD APPEARED TO ABRAHAM AND GAVE HIM A WORD TO FOLLOW HIM, INTO A DESTINATION ONLY HE WOULD REVEAL, ABRAHAM FORSOOK ALL THAT HE WAS FAMILIAR WITH AND SET OUT ON A JOURNEY WITH GOD. HAVING NO WAVERING SPIRIT, HE CONTINUED TO BE FAITHFUL AND OBE-  
DIENT TO ALL THAT GOD ASKED HIM TO DO.

One thing that Abraham did that was not in the plan of God for his life was to take along someone with him – that is, his nephew, Lot. Along the journey, the camp in which they made their dwelling became too small to occupy both of them and their possessions. Consequently, Abraham was forced to part ways with Lot, in order for them to grow independently and to avoid strife and unnecessary conflict. Hence Abraham told his nephew to seek a place that was good for him, but Lot instead chose for himself a place that was pleasing to his eyes.

Amazingly, it is when Lot left the company of Abraham that God started to speak to Abraham and to reveal the plan He had for him clearer and in deeper detail. This shows us that there are some situations in our lives that keep us from hearing the Voice of God clearly, because we are either distracted or doing things God never asked us to do. Sometimes we stay too long in an environment that is not conducive to hearing from God because our faith is hindered by circumstances we may find ourselves in.

But when we remove distractions and clear out our environment, we would start hearing the Voice of God and heeding the instruction that would ultimately help us to take the next steps with Him. Remember God never ordered Abraham to bring his nephew with him; although Abraham's deed seemed good, it wasn't the will of God for his life. Lot's company capped Abraham's faith and became like a lid that stopped him from hearing God. His faith was hindered by what was going around him. Instead of fixing his eyes on the Lord and following the blueprint that God communicated with him, he lost sight and became estranged from the presence of God.

The truth of the matter is that God never stopped giving him the wisdom and the direction to fulfil His call upon his life. God never stopped speaking to him concerning where he wanted him to be. His faith was not in alignment with the initial plan of God. The burden of doing the things that God hasn't asked him



to do kept him from spending time with God as he ought to.

The moment Abraham refocused his attention on God his faith was uncapped and unhindered. He started to hear the Voice of God again. He could follow through with the instruction from His Word and he started to walk with God again. I believe that all that we need to do for us to hear from God as Abraham is to remove hindrances and cease from the busyness of life. Learn to dedicate more time to the Lord and start following in His footsteps to where He is leading us.

Following Christ begins by listening and being obedient to His voice. The Word of the Lord in the book of John 10:27 says, *"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me"*. This text indicates to us that our God is always communicating His will with us as His children, and our posture is to always obey and follow. We need to be so connected to God that our ears are tuned in to His Voice and be in constant communion with Him.

Even in the 21st century, God still speaks the way He did in time past. He still gives instructions and direction, His Word is uncapped because of the revelation we received from His Spirit. Every time we spend time in the Word we would see how other responsibilities that are screaming for our attention fade away in the background as the vision of God becomes clearer. The Word of the Lord always gives wisdom, understanding and principles we should live by. To have an uncapped faith as Abraham did, we first and foremost need to learn from him.

Here are keys that can help us in following the plan of God and obeying His Word.

## 1. Walk with God.

We need to follow through with the vision that God has given us or the template of what He is asking of us. We need to come to a point where His footsteps are what we are searching for in order to follow the direction in which He is leading us. The most important thing to do in the journey that God has called us is to obey His first instruction and to remind ourselves that we are following the leader and not on our own.

## 2. Remove distractions.

The Bible declares that where there is unity God commands a blessing. That is, God blesses people who live according to His purposes and are obedient to His will; peace comes when we are obedient to God and respectful to one another. Where there is derision and strife, there cannot be unity, and the blessing of the Lord will be quenched.

## 3. Create an atmosphere that hosts the presence of God.

The Word of God is clear when it says that God inhabits the praise of His people. We need to be intentional in creating a place where the presence of God can move freely and be tangible. His Spirit is in us and moving

through us. But every time we focus on our problems and when we are distracted, we miss worshipping God and inviting him into our present moment.

## 4. Learn to hear the Voice of God.

Make time and read through the Word so that through revelation God can direct you and give you wisdom regarding decisions you should make. Our God is not a distant and unapproachable God; He is with us and He

promised to never leave us. So when we make room to listen we can start hearing His voice.

## 5. Be a doer of the Word - apply the principles.

What I love about Abraham is that he didn't just hear the voice of God but he followed - he did exactly what God called him to do. His faith was prompt to act and he did all God asked him to do. In all that we endeavour to do in life, we can achieve it if we faithfully and persistently follow the promptings of the Holy Spirit; and He leads and guides us continuously.

It is through uncapped faith that God brought forth His promise in Abraham's life. Because of that Abraham received what he believed God for and more. It is because of his faith that he was counted as having a right standing with God. He resembled a faith that is uncapped, unhindered and unwavering. As dear children of God, we have been given the same measure of faith to see the manifestation of all the promises of God in our lives.

To maximize your creativity, learn how to balance...

I have to admit being a bit of a Productivity Nerd. I have numerous cross-platform to-do apps on my computer, including Microsoft To Do, Things, and OmniFocus. (Currently, Things 3 is my favorite.) I’ve read all of David Allen’s books, track with my friend Michael Hyatt, and follow the guys over at Asian Efficiency. In my role as CEO, managing our team at Cooke Media Group, and working with our clients, productivity matters. It helps me keep track of what needs to be done, and keeps me on point to make it happen.

When you’re working with clients, if you can’t deliver, you’re out of business.

As David Allen says, half of our stress is knowing that there are things out there we need to do, but we can’t remember them all. Getting them down into a list, and then organizing and prioritizing that list lowers our stress, and helps us reach our goals.

However, when it comes to my creative work, productivity is far less important. Creativity is hard work, but it’s also about

inspiration, timing, and flow. When it comes to original ideas, you can’t just check off boxes and move on. Creativity is about blocking off times where you can think, read, and wander. It might be about taking a walk, shooting baskets, or doing nothing at all. You can learn far more about these secrets in my book “Ideas on a Deadline: How to Be Creative When the Clock is Ticking.”

The bottom line is that if you want to maximize your creativity (and who doesn’t?), learn to find that balance between productive time and creative time. After all, as much as I like checking off boxes of finished tasks, some of my most significant time is spent just staring out windows. Sometimes you have to schedule times just to reflect and do nothing in order to spark those creative moments.

# When it Comes to Children's Entertainment, Will Christians Answer Disney's Move?

**The recent developments should be a wake up call to Christians to produce higher quality children's programming**

UNLESS WE BACK UP CRITICISM WITH ACTION, NOTHING MUCH WILL CHANGE, AND THE OPTIONS FOR KIDS WILL SHRINK.

It's been an interesting couple of weeks for The Walt Disney Company and the revelations of just how "woke" many of their employees really are. In reaction to Florida's "Parental Rights in Education" bill, the battle lines were drawn, with the strategy of Disney's leadership revealing just how far the studio is moving toward creating programming that will introduce younger and younger children to LGBTQ+ and transexual ideology.

I'm not here to argue about Disney's choices, but to encourage Christians that it's time to step up and produce high quality children's programming from a Biblical perspective.

In a political reaction, conservative site Daily Wire is committing \$100 million to produce Children's programming featuring traditional values to counter the Disney initiatives.

But it's also time for Christians to invest

in our kids. I can tell you from decades working in Christian media that kid's programming (particularly on TV) has always been very poor (and that's being gracious.) There have been plenty of well intentioned attempts, but time after time they've fallen woefully short.

But now is the time to act. You can choose to cancel your Disney+ subscription or stop taking your kids to Disney movies, but that still doesn't offer a better entertainment alternative. Unless we back up criticism with action, nothing much will change, and the options for kids will shrink.

I'm not an expert in children's programming, but I'm putting the word out that it's time to make a difference.
