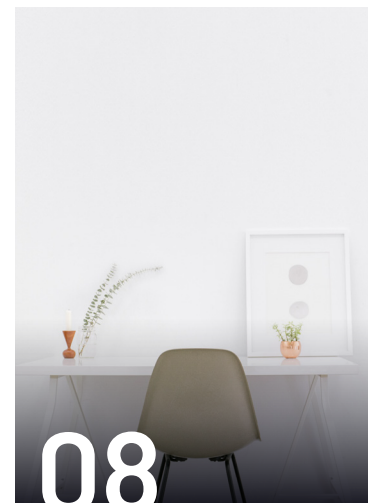
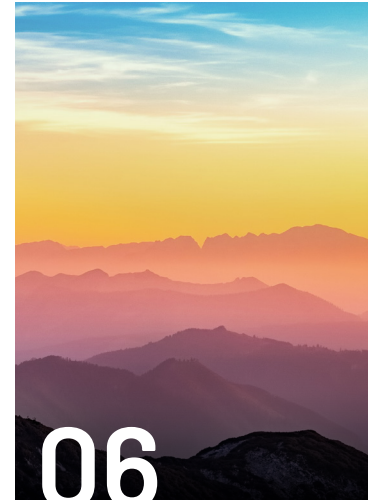

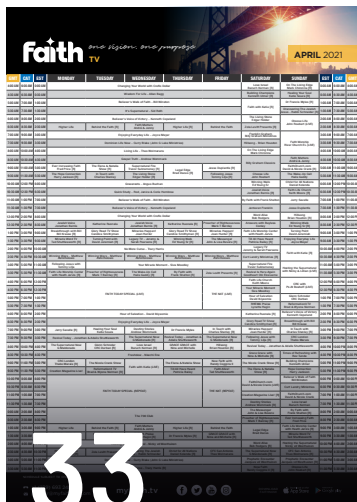

THE EARTH IS THE LORD'S

A little while ago we had an interesting conversation with a friend who was going through a difficult time in her life. She had made some wrong choices and had begun to walk away from her faith in the Lord as she slowly but surely retreated from any church related commitments.

As I spoke to her, I noticed a strange hardness that had begun to settle within her, especially when we spoke of the Lord. When I questioned her about her faith, I could see that her trust and hope in the Lord had dwindled. It appears she felt she would do a better job at finding happiness and security in life by her own means and choices. She began saying things like, "I think our trust in a sovereign God is somewhat overrated..." Then she said something to me that lodged itself in my mind and spiked my interest to research the matter. She spoke of the account in the book of Exodus where God led the people of Israel out of Egypt, where they had been captive slaves for a good four hundred years. What upset her the most about this remarkable story was the fact that scripture tells of God hardening Pharaoh's heart, causing him to remain stubborn and not release the Israelites out of slavery. "What kind of God hardens Pharaohs' heart so that all that destruction and calamity can come on so many innocent people?" she retorted. "Why would I put my trust in someone as manipulating as that? What kind of game was he playing?" I realized she was grasping at anything she could to justify her rebellious heart towards the Lord.

I remember paging through the Bible going over the account of the Great Escape of the Israelite nation and I saw the faithfulness of God avenging His own, beloved people. I underlined the scripture in Exodus 9:29 that says, **"Moses said to him (Pharaoh), As soon as I leave this city, I will stretch out my hands to the Lord; the thunder**

shall cease, neither shall there be any more hail, that you may know that the earth is the Lords."

History teaches us that the Israelite nation got into really difficult, life-threatening circumstances, be it from sickness and slavery to death on the battle field and at home because of their stubborn refusal to put their trust in the Lord and follow His leading. Of their own free will they chose the lure of foreign gods and immoral cultures over their devotion to their God. Yet every time, by His grace, God gave His people a way of restitution and reconciliation. His unending love and patience towards them were amazing.

When the Israelites served under the Egyptian rule, God heard their cry of distress and once again turned His face towards them to make a way of freedom available, against all odds. God knew the nature of the Israelite slaves, for hundreds of years they were under the whip and cruelty of their Egyptian masters. Despite their great numbers, their moral and confidence as a nation was marred and stunted by their slave mentality, etched in the very fiber of their hearts and minds. Many of them had grown accustomed to the Egyptian culture and way of life, including the way they worshipped foreign gods and the moral decay in their value system was evident. Their faith in the one true God was very weak and their distrust in Moses as their savior was enormous, since he had fled as a wanted criminal and abandoned them for some years. The only way God could stir up within them

the courage and trust in their almost forgotten faith was by His miraculous had of supernatural power and miracles! If Pharaoh's heart had not been hardened, God's chosen people would never have witnessed the display of His might and their hope in a God of the impossible would never have been ignited. God gave a bold and deliberate display of His awesome power through each plague, sign and wonder. He declared to all the world that He truly was God and that the earth and all its fullness was His.

What if God's people never saw the great plagues of Egypt and never reached the courage to trust in Him again? What if God's people failed to see that their own savior was the One who fashioned the universe and made the earth and all that lives within it? God in all His wisdom chose a peculiar remnant of people and established His very own blood line through them that His own Son would come from out of them and be the savior of all mankind.

I am convinced that the plagues over Egypt were terrible and extremely fearsome to behold. However, from scripture it is clear that every household that believed in the Most High God and chose to put their trust in Him was miraculously saved and unharmed by the destruction and calamity that ravaged through the land.

To live in that space of time must have been both awful and wonderful. It reminds me of the times Paul warns us of when he addressed the Christians in the seaport of Thessalonica. At that time, it was incredibly dangerous and difficult to live out their Christian faith as persecution for their beliefs was particularly severe and harsh. Yet Paul warned of

a time where events all over the world would occur of catastrophic proportions. They would cause shock and alarm and throw the world into a state of distress. (2 Thessalonians 2:2)

Paul urges us to resist being easily shaken up by these events and to take charge over the fearful thoughts that will assault our minds. He encourages us to take heart and put our trust in a never changing God Who honors His Word above all else. This God of the impossible Who avenges those who put their trust in Him. This God Who from the beginning of time itself put into motion a glorious purpose for a beautiful world and carefully designed and created the earth and all its fullness. This is the God in Whom we are to put our trust.

What if we, in our own selfish ambition fail to hold on to our faith in God and get swept away in the everyday affairs of life? What if we too become so entangled by the rat race of life around us that we lose our intimacy with Him? What if we become contaminated by the moral decay of our society and begin to lose our very identity as those who trust in the Lord? What does God have to do to get our attention or awaken our hope and faith in Him in the world we live today? What will it take to see that He truly is God and is not surprised or mocked by the events the world is currently facing?

I, like Paul urge you to make a choice to live on purpose for Him today. Understand that He is a sovereign God and that at the end, every knee will bow to His Lordship and give account for the way we lived on His earth. At that time, all will see that He truly is God and that the earth and all its fullness are His.

The simple baked beans became four side dishes I labored over.

Insecure and wanting to impress everyone, I spent the week cleaning and getting everything in the house to the point where I thought my guests would be impressed. Of course, the lawn chairs were old, so I bought new ones. I got angry at my husband, Dave, because I thought he wasn't helping me enough, and by the time our friends arrived, I even resented them! I wished they hadn't come, and I had a horrible time pretending to be the happy hostess when, in reality, I was frustrated and miserable.

I could not figure out why I wasn't able to enjoy much of anything in life until God revealed to me that I was killing my joy with complication. For years, I prayed for God to change the people and circumstances around me when it was actually me He wanted to change.

EXPRESSIONS OF LOVE AND WORSHIP

Dancing is a beautiful expression of deep emotion and has often been linked to spiritual demonstrations of passion. While the conservative sometimes tends to view dancing as carnal expressions, many more progressive thinkers see the legitimacy of dancing as an expression of worship.

There's something special about the 'first dance' between a bride and her groom on their wedding day. The guests stand by and gaze, outsiders, as the couple becomes entranced in the intimacy of the moment.

Their eyes, smiles and bodies embrace as time stands still. It's one of those Hollywood moments, where everything and everyone around the couple disappears into a blur... at that moment nobody else seems to exist.

What is it about dancing that inspires us so much? Think about the millions of dollars that dancing movies have grossed at the box office. The plots are not particularly enthralling; and yet the movies inspire - if you're a girl anyway! (I suppose for the guys as well since he always seem to get the girl in the end!)

The Bible is filled with images of people dancing. King David danced before the Lord in celebration even though he was misunderstood as He expressed his joy through this ancient art form. His wife, Michal, scolded him for behaving in such an undignified manner. It seems that not much has

changed as we fast forward to the present day.

There are many who criticize dance within the church and deny that it is an acceptable form of worship. Whatever your opinion on the issue, I'd like to propose that dance can be an expression of worship before the Lord.

Just as a bride and groom embark on a journey of intimacy with their first dance, we too are able to express our deep desire for God through dance. Words are not always adequate but dance is a further expression of our heart's desire to know, love and worship God. With arms raised, feet moving, and bodies twirling our bodies are able to communicate that which our lips are unable to utter. Surely, this is what we were created for - to worship God with reckless abandon - our eyes fixed only on Him.

More than just an expression of love, dancing, as a form of worship, is a heart issue. Our heart's motive needs to be pure before the Lord. The moment that it becomes about a polished performance (although we should seek for excellence in all that we do), or about looking good in order to impress



people, it loses its effectiveness. Worship dancing should always be reverent and modest since it is not a platform for showing off toned bodies or inappropriate gestures. It is far more than a performance!

A friend of mine once told me that we should not dance for God. Instead, we should dance with Him. What a beautiful concept! Can you imagine, laying aside our worries, fears and concerns as we dance with the very inventor of dance and all the other aesthetically gratifying art forms! How quickly we forget that our God is the ultimate artist!

Dance within the church is frequently presented as an item of entertainment. The audience is given an opportunity to connect with God as they witness a worship or praise dance; however, the true effectiveness of this art form is experienced by the dancers as they lose themselves in the Father's

love, glory and beauty.

There is a freedom and joy to be found in worship dancing that cannot be explained. Perhaps it is because God Himself delights in His children's pure expression of love and worship. They say that body language comprises 90% of our communication. How apt, then, that our bodies should communicate and proclaim the praises of God!

Jesus used 'wedding' imagery time and again, particularly when speaking about His Second Coming. He is the groom and we are His bride. May we become so enraptured with our groom that we lose ourselves in His embrace as we express our desire for intimacy with Him through the graceful and rhythmic art of dance. **"Praise Him with the tambourine and dancing!" (Psalm 150:4)**

SHOULD CHRISTIANS BE SNARKY ON SOCIAL MEDIA?

How far should we go when
responding to questions or
criticism?

We've all had our moments – *when someone attacks us with a comment of such sheer stupidity that you just can't let it slide.* So rather than be outright mean, we just answer in a condescending, snarky way that nails them – and at the same time puts them in their place. (And firmly establishes our intellectual superiority.)

I could name a few very intelligent Christians who do it regularly. It could be those who are so sure of their theology, they just can't let any of those heretics get by. It's also a regular tool for Christians who are trying WAY too hard to appear liberal and broadminded – and are happy to put those of us who are just too narrow in our place. And it certainly happens on a wide range of topics from politics, to culture, to theology, to movie reviews.

They can often be very funny, but is that really the way Christians should respond?

Like I said, I'm as guilty as anybody, but in almost every case, I immediately feel badly about it. I may feel great for a moment, but the minute I hit "Send," conviction starts creeping in.

And I hate seeing people I know end up on the losing end of the stick when they simply brought up an honest question to someone they admired – only to get slammed for it.

Looking over a number of those posts recently, I just wonder what the rest of the world thinks. When our answers to each other (and to non-believers) are so condescending – even hostile – I can't help but wonder if outsiders look at us and see no difference between us and the world.

I'm not making a point here, I'm just thinking out loud. And in that process, thinking that I could do a much better job of responding to questions and even criticism with a little more grace.


After all, there's a difference between answers that make people think, and answers that humiliate.

And I've never met anyone who accepted Christ because he or she was embarrassed into the decision.

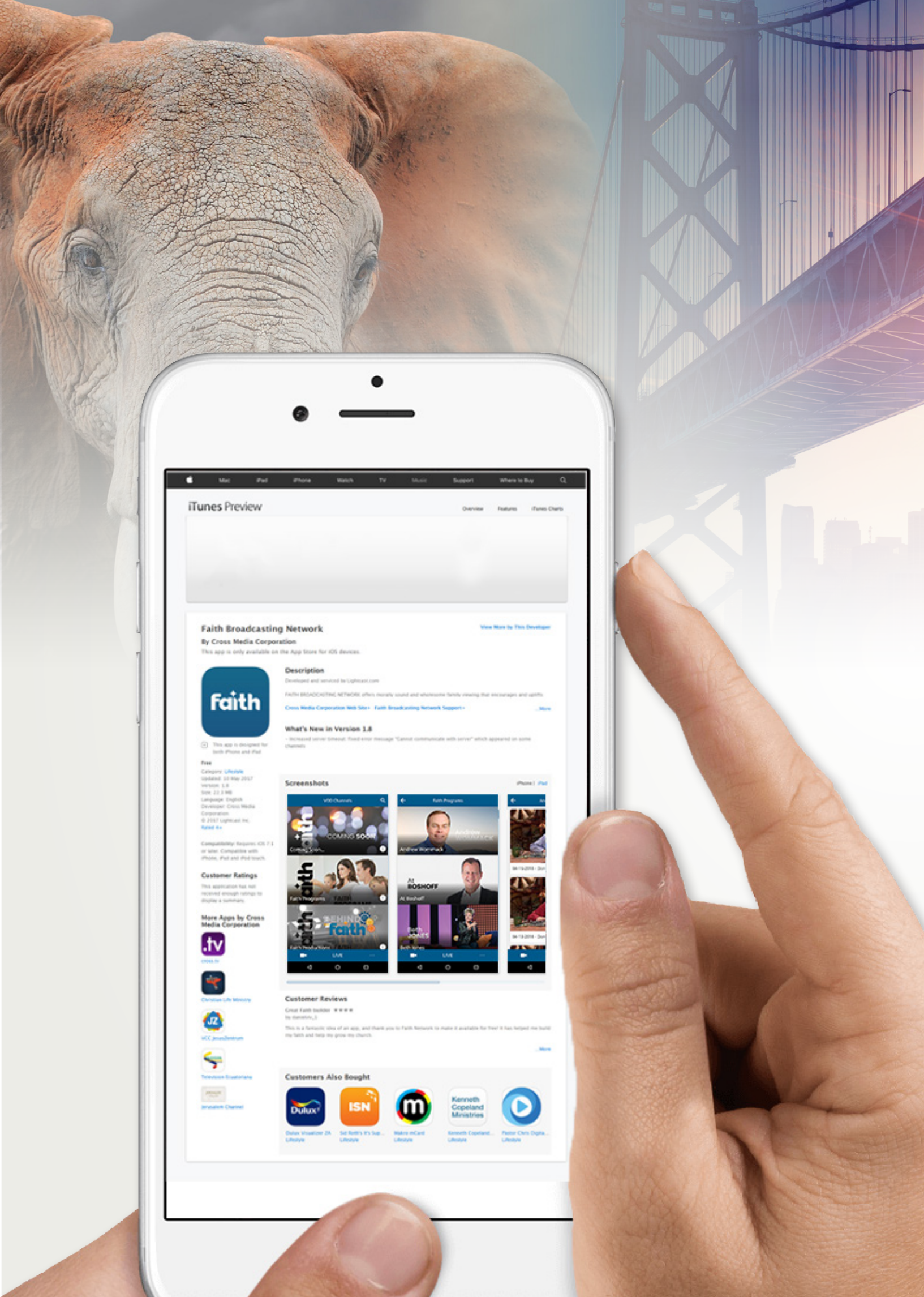

THE ABC OF PURPOSE: UVWX

Understand:

"Seek first to understand."

Question the things that happen in your life. Certain things come across your path to challenge you so you can grow or develop a particular character trait while others come to distract you and pull you off course. To fulfil your purpose it is important to understand the difference. We need to discern between the two. Everything that happens in my life and yours can either move us towards our goals, dreams or desires, or it can keep us from them. The sooner we can identify the end objective of a situation we find ourselves in, the sooner we can take the appropriate action. Either we need to refocus on our vision so we are not distracted by some possible detour, or we need to strengthen our resolve to proceed through a particular situation and allow ourselves to develop the character trait that will equip us for our destiny.

WHAT GREAT OPPORTUNITY IS LYING HIDDEN IN YOUR CHALLENGE?

Vision:

"Vision: The ability to see something beyond what others are looking at." Glen A. McQuirk

There are two distinct ways that we can see; the one way is governed by physical-sight, and the other by mind-sight. What we are able to see with our physical eyes does not differ much from person to person, but what we are able to visualize with our minds eye or imagination differs immensely. What we see with our two eyes often limits us and keeps us from taking action while what we can imagine or dream forces us to do something. Often people switch between the two. One moment they have an incredibly powerful dream or vision and the next moment they open their eyes and look

at the circumstances they find themselves in and quickly give up on the dream. They confuse the facts they see with their naked eye with the truth of the future possibilities they witnessed with their minds eye.

Obtain the input of wise counsel. Napoleon Hill in his book 'Think and Grow Rich' refers to a Master Mind group. In MAP4LIFE™ I use the term Success Team. It is a group of people from diverse backgrounds that you interact with regularly and who advise you on a formal or informal basis. I think we all realise that individually we do not have all the answers, but collectively we have so much more knowledge. Being too proud to ask the advice of others is foolish. Two brains together could be ten times more powerful than two on their own. It is incredible how a few ideas you have can translate into multiple ideas when you begin to share them with someone else. Be brave, build a success team, a group of people who share your vision and want the best for you.

WHO SHOULD FORM PART OF YOUR SUCCESS TEAM?

TRAINING OUR CHILDREN

Well, ask a parent what lesson their child should be learning and using in their everyday life; and I am quite certain that you would get a different answer depending on the phase their child is going through. As much as this might be the case, at the core of each lesson is a desire to somehow pour into their child's character.

So, what is character? *Dictionary.com* defines character as; the aggregate of features and traits that form the individual nature of some person or thing. Another definition used refers to a person's behaviour and personality. Furthermore, as parents (or as an influence in a young person's life) do you want to risk the possibility that your child will have no good words to fight all the bad words that constantly attack their character?

I have come across too many people who fail to recognize the potential that I effortlessly see in them. They constantly see themselves defined by their circumstances. They don't have

enough people telling them that they CAN, instead they have got circumstances screaming at how they CAN'T. Our environments influence our personalities, which in turn form part of our characters; negative environments are "building blocks" for negative attitudes and characters! I am passionate about helping to bring about change... I want to tell young people around the world how beautiful and intelligent they are. And I will be able to do it with so much confidence because I know how true it is. I know how true it is because God says so in His word in Genesis 1:27, "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them."

And well, God is all these great things, and more-He is perfection itself. But just as so many other people, I keep saying I want to do all this one day...Why can't I do it now. Why can't I begin to water every young person's character that I come across right now? Why can't I start with the child in my life right now-my nephew? Why can't we all begin to train our children by starting with the ones that we have direct contact with daily. It doesn't have to be some huge speech; it only starts with us emphasizing how smart they are when they get things right. It begins with us saying how good they are when they do the right thing. It's about us showing them how important they are by telling them how great and loved they really are to us. All these little things that we take for granted are the things that ultimately determine the roles that our children play in society as the adults they ultimately become.

We constantly complain about the government, about the "powers that be" in this world we live in. What we fail to realise, is that the little people we are raising up become the presidents and ministers and so-called role models in this world. So, what should we do? Well, what do organizations do on a regular basis to ensure that their personnel are equipped and ready to handle the challenges faced daily by their corporations? They are constantly training them; constantly pouring large funds into these training seminars. And so we should do the same-we should train our children daily, to ensure that they develop characters that will help create a better society for future generations to live in.

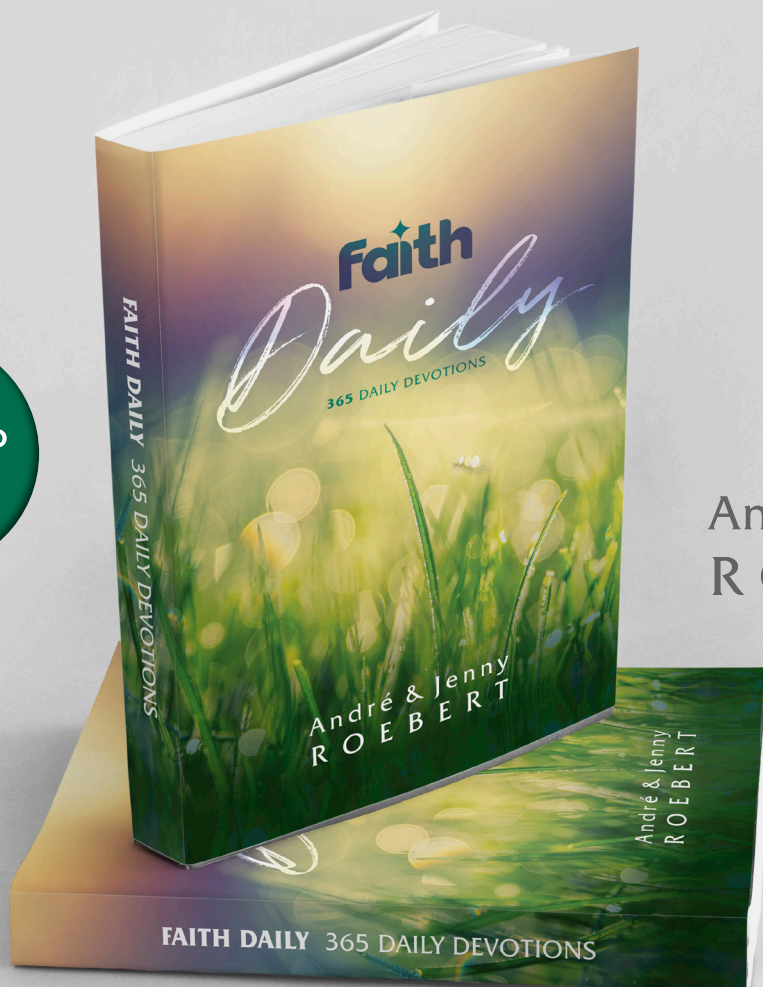

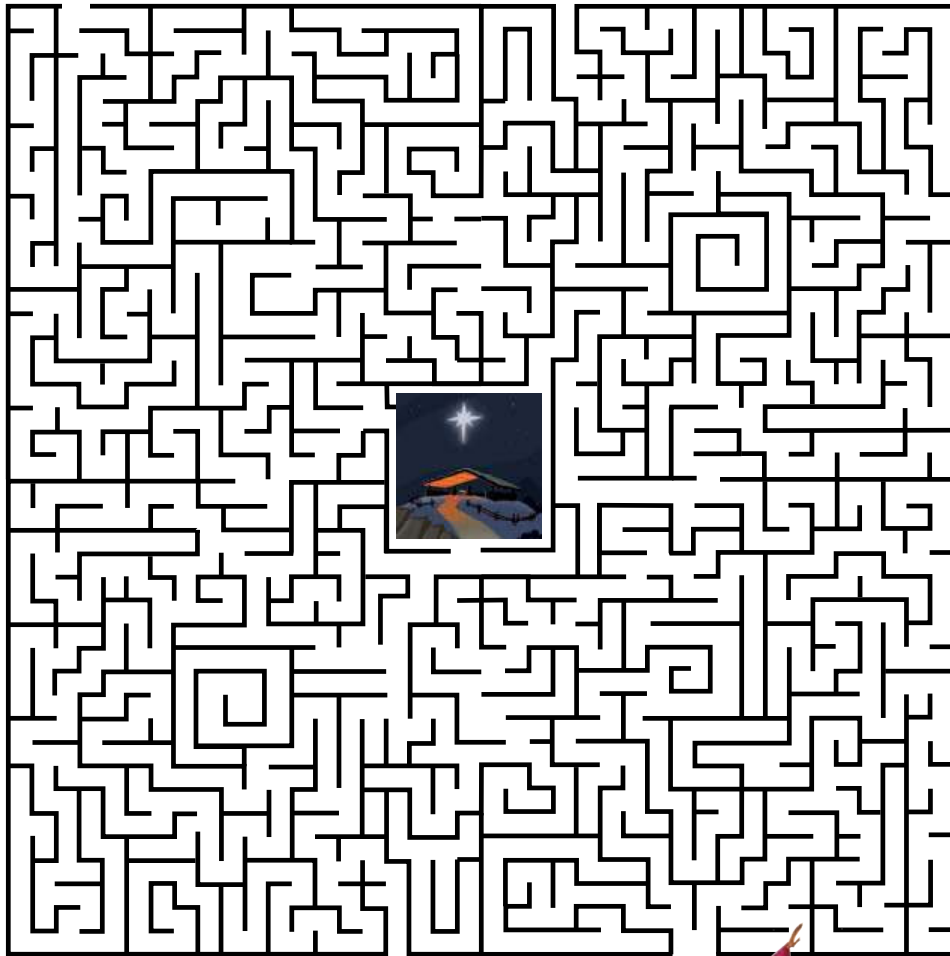

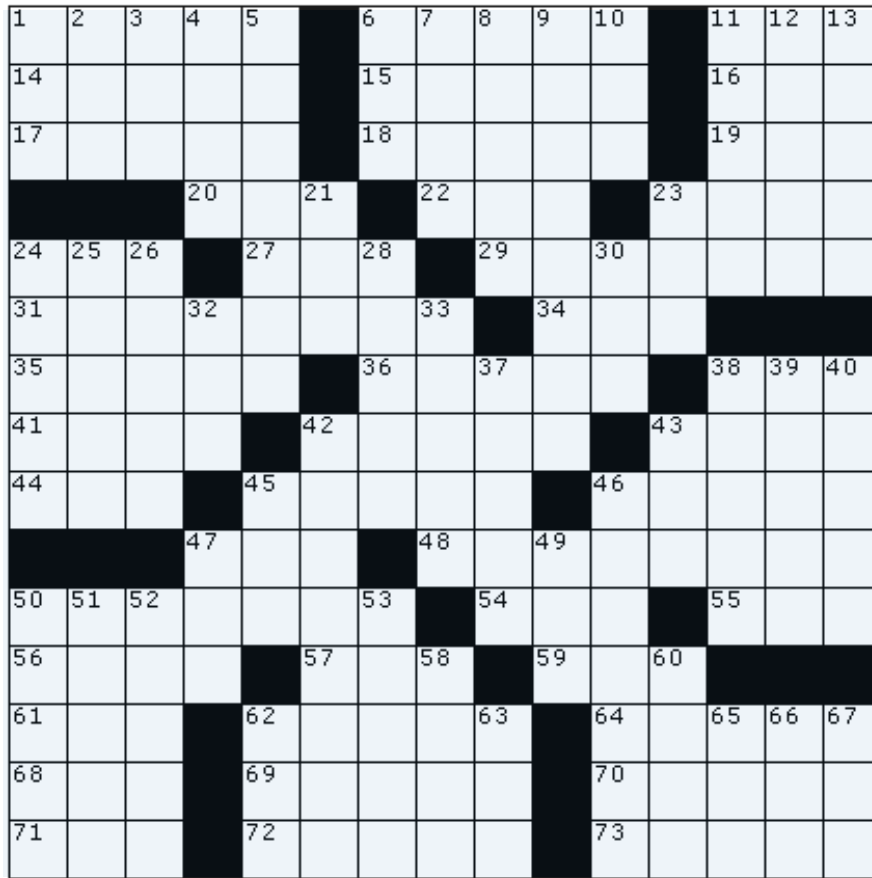
